115 ft. to an iron stake thence  
South <sup>South</sup> parallel to N. East  
line East St. 130 ft. to an  
iron stake thence South 133  
to an iron stake in N. line  
of East St. 133' thence ~~thence~~  
parallel to N. line Cass St. 132  
to point of beginning  
all corners marked with

Lots A6-A7-A8-A9  
The 4 are 1<sup>st</sup> lot 6 is 63 ft wide  
and the other 4 are 50' each  
making 263' all told N. & S.  
and 229' East and West  
to be divided north and south  
into two lots. The West lot  
to be 115' by 263. East lot  
114' by 263. Block A. Phillips  
& Purdie's subdivision of both  
the West part of Block  
5 Phillips subdivision of  
Large lot 3, Plat of original  
Village of Geneva,  
said Block 5 was 532' E/W,  
and 293' N. & S. 30' allowed  
for 1/2 Curtin St. and 30' for  
1/2 of Cass St. 20' for alley  
229' for west 1/2 and 219' for  
East 1/2.

We first searched for stakes  
around Block 5. One iron  
stake found at N. E. Cor. No  
others. Search for other Block

then found an old cast

surface and 9 1/2 ft West of Darwin  
Street West walk.  
Sighted <sup>with transit</sup> from this stake East,  
to stake at N. E. Cor. Block Phillips  
sub. measured East on old  
line and made point 9.4' East  
of East walk on East St.  
then 115' East + made point  
for N. W. Cor. of alley.  
Set iron stakes at both make  
points. Lined in with transit  
from E. line East walk on  
East St. measured 263' south  
and made point, with transit  
on this point, sighted on stake  
at N. W. walk cor. Darwin & East  
St. turned right angle East and  
measured East on ~~229'~~ 115' made  
point. and 214' further East  
and made point Set 3 iron

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at S. W. Cor, Block 5 and  
on S. line of Block 5, 145'  
East, and 224' East,  
Said survey land is 224'  
E. & W, 268' N. & S, Divided  
North and South into two  
lots 115' & 114' E & W, & each
