DESCRIPTION OF LANDS OWNED BY BELL CURTIS IN THE CITY OF LAKE
GENEVA, WIS. Begin at a point in the East Range line of township
of Geneva, Wis., Walworth County, 1024.5 ft. North of the S.E. Cor. of Sect
36 in said township; thence North in said range line 538 feet; thence West
in the South line of large lot Five, Original plat of Geneva Village
284 ft. more or less to the southwesterly line of the C. & N.W.R.R. Right
of way; thence Northwesterly along said Right of Way line 575 ft. to
the North line of said large lot five; thence West ^{800 ft.} to the North
line of said large lot Five to the Center of Wells St. in said City;
thence South in the center line of Wells St. to the Southwest Cor. of
said large lot Five; thence Southwest in the center of Logan Ave. of
said City 723 feet; thence East 1012 feet to the place of beginning.

Excepting from the tract included in this description, the portion
included in the said railroad right of way and the home lot reserved
by Belle Curtis described as follows;

Begin at the intersection of the central lines of Logan Ave.,
Campbell and Wells Streets in said city; thence east in the South line
of said large lot Five 450 feet to an iron stake; thence South 200 ft.
to an iron stake; thence west 325.5 ft. to the center of Logan Ave.;
thence Northwest in the center line of Logan Ave. to the point of
beginning;

The entire tract contains 25.3 acres exclusive of R.F. Right of
way and 23.55 acres more or less exclusive of reserved home lot.
