My Dear Mr. Walker, I met stakes for your lot and Mr. Hand's this afternoon but did not have time to go and see you. I was at work near there and did your work. The N.W. corner of your lot is about 4 inches north of the south line of your north walk. I made a notch in the cement walk. The N.E. corner of your lot is about 2 inches north of the south line of the walk and just at the dividing line of your walk and Mr. Manley's. An iron stake is set under the walk. The S.E. corner of your lot and N.E. corner of Mr. Hand's lot is marked by iron stake in the roots of that large soft maple. The S.W. corner of your lot and N.W. of Hand's is marked by an iron stake as is also Mr. Hand's S.W. corner. Hand's S.W. corner is marked by a notch in the alley cement driveway about 7 inches south of its north line. Lots 6 & 7 each 96 feet north and south and 60 feet east and west.

Charges are seventy five cents.
