Begin at ^{an iron stk} inter of N. line
of Cass St. and East St.
Phillips subdivision and
addition to village of
Geneva. Thence N. or in
East line East St. 133'
to an iron stk. Thence
East parallel to North
line at Cass. Thence East
115 ft. to an iron stk. Thence
South ^{South} parallel to N. East
line East St. 130 ft. to an
iron stk. Thence South 133
to an iron stk. in N. line
of East St. 133'. Thence
parallel to N. line Cass St. 133'
to point of beginning
all corners marked with
iron or wood stks.

Lots, A6-A7-A8-A9
The 1st lot 6 is 63 ft wide
and the other 4 are 50' each
making 263' all told N. & S.
and 229' East and West
to be divided north and south
into two lots. The West lot
to be 114' by 263'. East lot
114' by 263'. Block A. Phillips
& Pender's subdivision of both
the West part of Block
5 Phillips subdivision of
Large lot 3, Plat of original
Village of Geneva,
said Block 5 was 582' E & W,
and 298' N. & S. 30' allowed
for 1/2 Curtin St. and 30' for
1/2 of Cass St. 20 ft for alley
229' for west 1/2 and 219' for
East 1/2.

We first searched for stakes
around Block 5. One iron
stake found at N. E. Cor. NO
others. Search for other Block
Four. Found one iron stake

at N. E. Cor. Lot 3. Holly Cor.
then found an old cast

Set by H. H. Lubber at N. E. Cor. of

surface and 9 1/2 ft West of Darwin
Street West walk.
Sighted ^{with transit} from this stake East
to stake at N. E. Cor. Block Phillips
sub. measured East on old
line and made point 9.4' East
of East walk on East St.
then 115' East + made point
for N. W. Cor. of alley.
Set iron stakes at both made
points. Lined in with transit
from E line East walk on
East St. measured 268' south
and made point, with transit
on this point, sighted on stake
at N. W. walk cor. Darwin & East
St. turned right angle East and
measured East ~~on 229'~~ 115' made
point. and 214' further East
and made point Set 3 iron

at S. W. Cor, Block 5 and
on S. line of Block 5, 145'
East. and 228' East,
Said survey land is 228'
