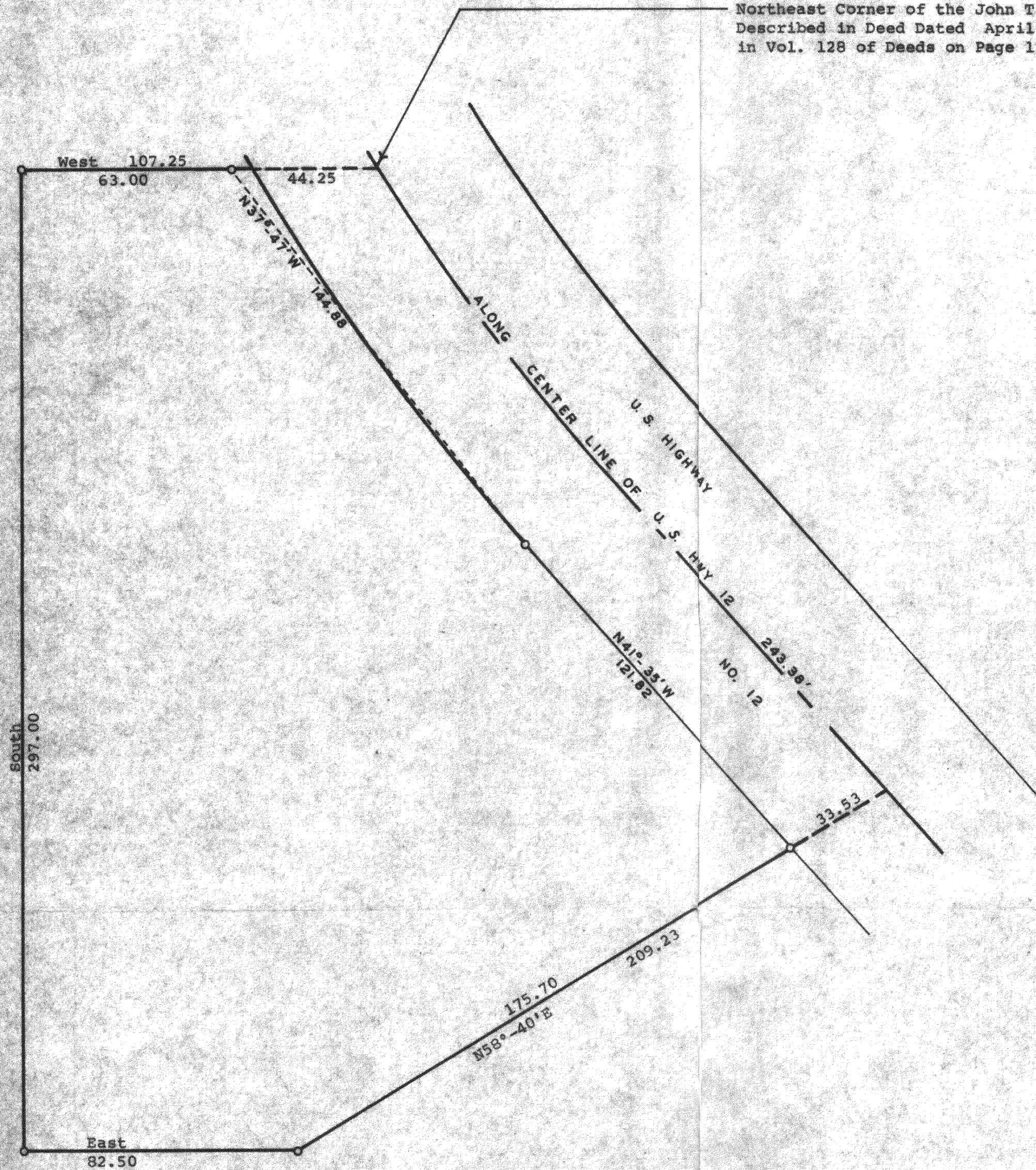


GEORGE T. DUNHAM

Plat of survey of a parcel of land located in the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of
Section 3, T 4 N, R 15 E, City of Whitewater, Walworth County,
Wisconsin, described as follows, to-wit: Commencing in the center
of the Elkhorn Road at the Northeast corner of the John T. Heuerman
farm and as described in deed dated April 12th, 1917, recorded in
Vol. 128 of Deeds on Page 128, Walworth County Records; thence West
along the north line of said Heuerman farm 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ rods; thence South at
right angles to said north line 18 rods; thence East at right angles
to said West line 5 rods; thence Northeasterly to the Elkhorn Street or
Road and being at a point in said road 14- $\frac{3}{4}$ rods from the place of
beginning; thence Northwest along the center of said road to the place
of beginning.
