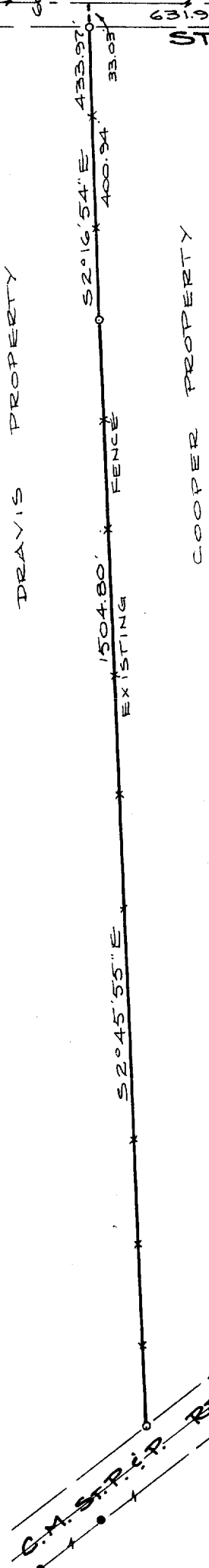
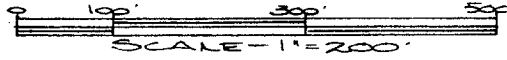
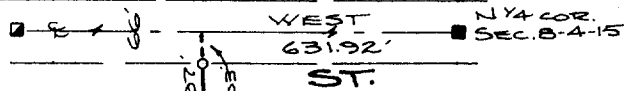


PLAT OF SURVEY

- Found 1" Iron Pipe
- Found 1 1/4" Iron Pipe
- Set 1"x24" Iron Pipe

DESCRIPTION

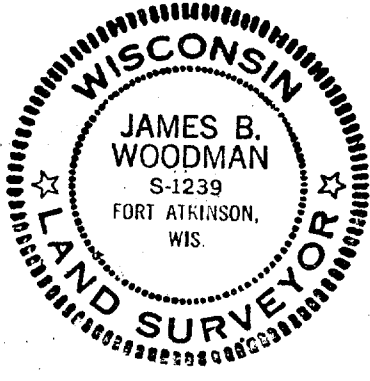
