The plat here given is a partial map of Wm. Wrigley Jr's grounds at Lake Geneva, Wis. It is a sketch and not intended for a finished map. The scale of maps and plats is uniform Hor. 100' to 1" and vertical 6' to 1". The boundary description is the recorded description. Stakes are set at all angles and the elevation above the lake is marked in these points. The distances of the different survey courses are continuous from starting point to termination. Size of buildings is not considered, location only. Survey routes are as follows: No. 1- from gate to lake by east road, No. 2- from house to junction of road with 1st route, No. 3- from stake south of barn to highway gate, No. 4- from elevation 57.08 around Gardner's house, No. 5- from elevation 57.08 to proposed wood shed site. The lower hydrant, S.W. bolt is used as a bench mark. The width of the drives is approximate; some are 15', some 18', some indefinite. Distance A to B is 226', distance B to C is 195'.
