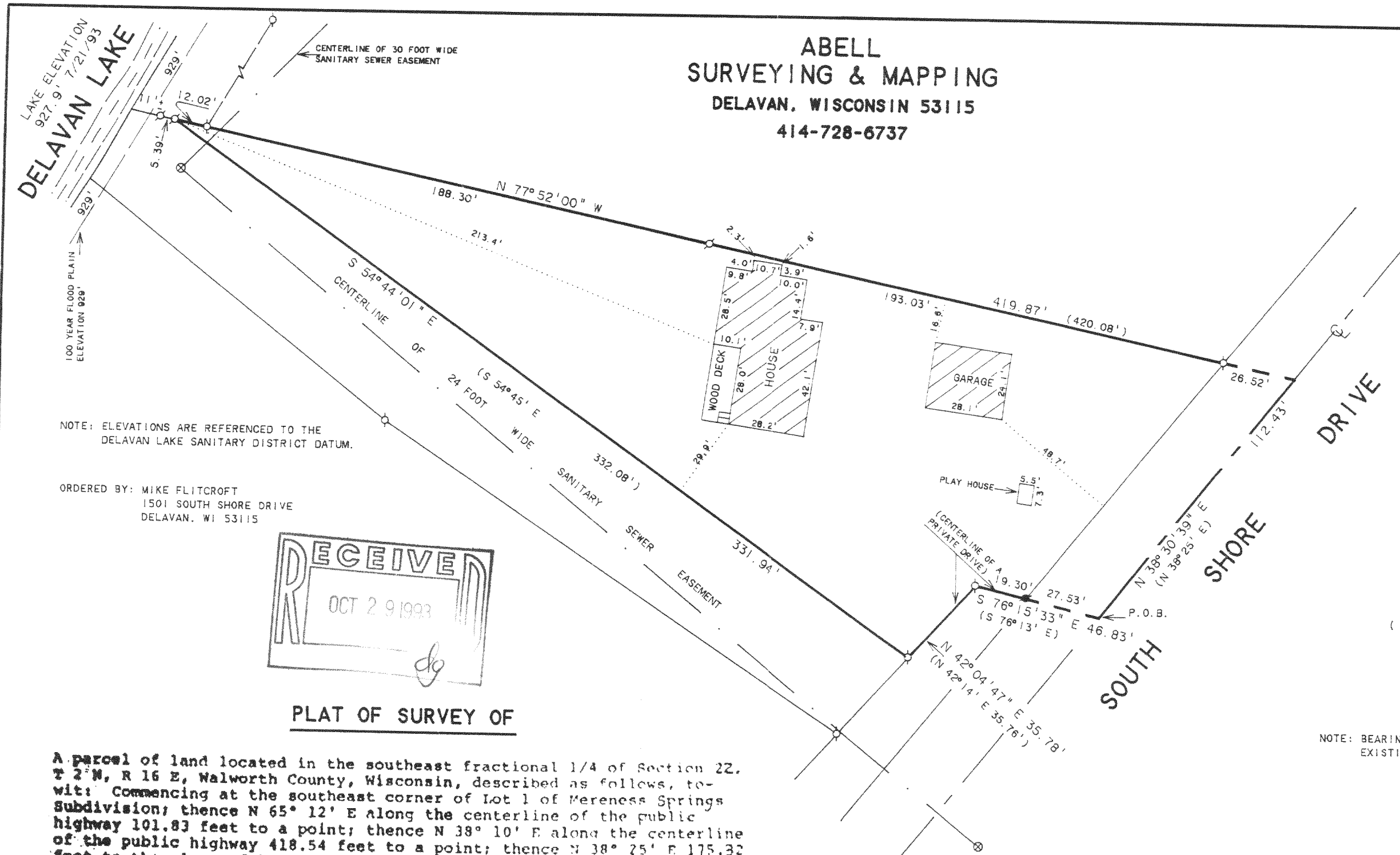
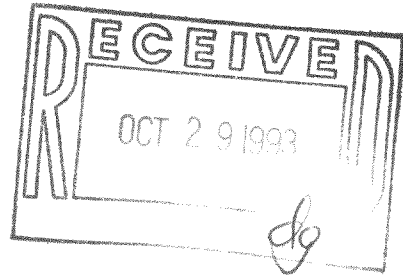

PLAT OF SURVEY OF

A parcel of land located in the southeast fractional 1/4 of Section 22, T 2 N, R 16 E, Walworth County, Wisconsin, described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the southeast corner of Lot 1 of Mereness Springs Subdivision; thence N 65° 12' E along the centerline of the public highway 101.83 feet to a point; thence N 38° 10' E along the centerline of the public highway 418.54 feet to a point; thence N 38° 25' E 175.32 feet to the place of beginning; thence continue N 38° 25' E along the centerline of the public highway 112.43 feet to the southeast corner of land owned by Anita Morelli; thence N 77° 52' W along the southwesterly line of said Anita Morelli land 420.08 feet to a point; thence S 54° 45' E 332.08 feet to a point in the centerline of a private drive; thence N 42° 14' E along the centerline of said private drive 35.76 feet to a point; thence S 76° 13' E along the centerline of said private drive 46.83 feet to the place of beginning. The above described land is subject to a right-of-way to be used by others over and along that part of the drive that is shown in the description, 1/2 of which lies on the above described land.
