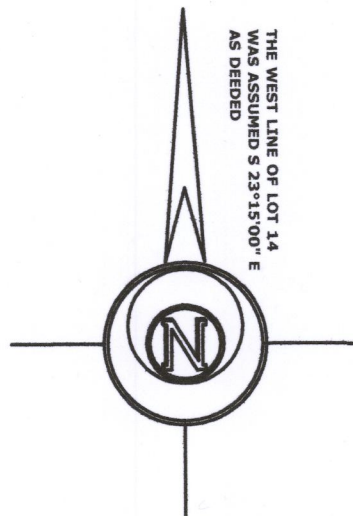

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

A parcel of land located in the redivision of Block 1 of Carswells Park as shown on a plat by William Child, County Surveyor, dated AUG. 17, 1929 & SEPT. 21, 1929, located in the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 35, Town 4 North, Range 16 East, LaGrange Township, Walworth County, Wisconsin, described as follows: Commence at the Center of said Section 35; THENCE N 89°52'15" E along the South line of the Northeast 1/4 of said Section 35, 870.21 feet to a meander corner; THENCE N 48°13'33" E 2371.88 feet to a specified stake as shown on said plat by William Child; Thence N 45°36'14" W 146.97 feet to a found iron rod and the POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE S 11°29'19" E 56.60 feet to a found P.K. nail; THENCE N 87°00'12" W 34.01 feet to a found iron rod on a meander line; THENCE continue N 87°00'12" W 2.80 feet to the shore of Turtle Cove; THENCE Northwest along the shore of Turtle Cove 95' more or less to a point that is S 66°45'18" W 3.00 feet from a set iron rod; THENCE N 66°45'18" E 3.00 feet to a set iron rod on a meander line, which is N 32°18'45" W 95.56 feet from the previously mentioned meander corner; THENCE continue N 66°45'18" E 57.09 feet to a point; THENCE S 23°15'00" E 54.00 feet to a found iron rod which is the POINT OF BEGINNING, and containing 4,989 square feet or 0.1145 acre(s) of land, more or less.
