as presented by the courses and distances on the following plat, and annexed field-notes of survey:
Established the center of the section of the south intersection of street and quarter lines.
Established all quarter-quarter corners upon the section boundaries at proportional distances between known
section and quarter section corners, according to the original field-notes of the Government survey.
Established all lost corners at proportionate distances between known corners, according to the original field
notes of the Government survey.
This is to certify that I, William Childs, County Surveyor of Wisconsin, have this day made a survey of lot 4 and block 7 of Trapps Add. to the City of Milwaukee. For the purpose of establishing the side lines of said lot 4. My survey was made in the following manner. At the west & south cor. of blk 4 found post hole which I believe to be corner of blk. Set stake in center of these post holes and produce line established by these two points to the southeast side of Ann Street, from point where this line intersects said southeast line of said street, measure 5 W 126.4 feet to line of fence on S. W. side of lot 15, blk 5 of said Addition. And 132 feet more and make point. From the line of fences at or near S. corner of said lot 15 measure Southwest 132 feet and make point. Produced the Southwest line of blk. 4 as above mentioned N. W. into railroad land and made point. And from this point measured S. W. parallel with Ann Street 126.4 ft. + 132 ft. = 258.4 feet and make point. And find this last mentioned point to be in line with points made 132 ft. S. W. from line of fence on S. W. side of above mentioned lot 15. Set stakes on this line across blk 7 for N. E. line of lot 4 and also 82.5 ft. S. W. of this line for S. W. side of said lot 4.

Began at S. W. cor. of cemetery, E 5.17 to center of fence post at S E. corner. Take post at S E. corner to her right and from the E 30 find remains of old stake at 200 more find post hole take post at S E. corner of cemetery and fence post East and find this line is line of fence on South of mill and 19 to post hole at 230 East of cemetery. Began at East of ally on what appeared from line of barn to be the west line of lot 1, N 30 + 53 set stake to right to. At N. W. corner of lot 9 found stone in line with barns South, from this stone W. at $30 + 200 + 75 = 305$ center of fence post in line of fence, from this stone E 250 + 100 to East side of post in small piece of fence South. From post 305 W. of stone, ran N 3.73 set stake in line of fence, then S. E. to stake on an stake set at 4.74 fence on NW of st. 127 SW of post at S E corner of lot 1, Blk 9. From line on E. of block 9 at this point E 70 to point 200 + 30 from E. side of ally. Found line of R. R. as ran by surveyors last fall which seems to be the center of old grade. Turned off R.R. and gave 50 feet, then 91 links which is end of fence on W of Blk 9 said being on the $N 44\frac{1}{2}$ W. of the point 3.73 W of NE a of blk.

Began at NW corner of cemetery, E 5.19 NE on center of post and 3.30 from this post set flag and ran S. to S E. corner of school lot, from S E. corner of school lot N 15 rds and set oak stake. Then set stake 12 rds W. & parallel with road south.

Began on line from pt. 83 W. of E. end of ally on State street to post 3.73 W. of post that 3.05 W. of stone at NW corner of lot 9 and turned off R.R. and ran W. 91 links then $116\frac{1}{3}$ to center of R. R. as staked.

Ran line 91 SW of line ran & on this line set stake on N. of blk for NE. cor. of R.R. land from this SW at R.R. $114\frac{2}{3}$ to line of R.R. as staked. And at $272\frac{1}{2}$ ran line parallel to line 91 SW & from this line ran line $251\frac{2}{3}$ SW of that line then at S. end ran W. on N of State St., at 129 W of street NW at 4.61 S E. of school lot, from NW cor. of piece E 2.25 to E. line of St. S E and 9.68 center of Blk.
