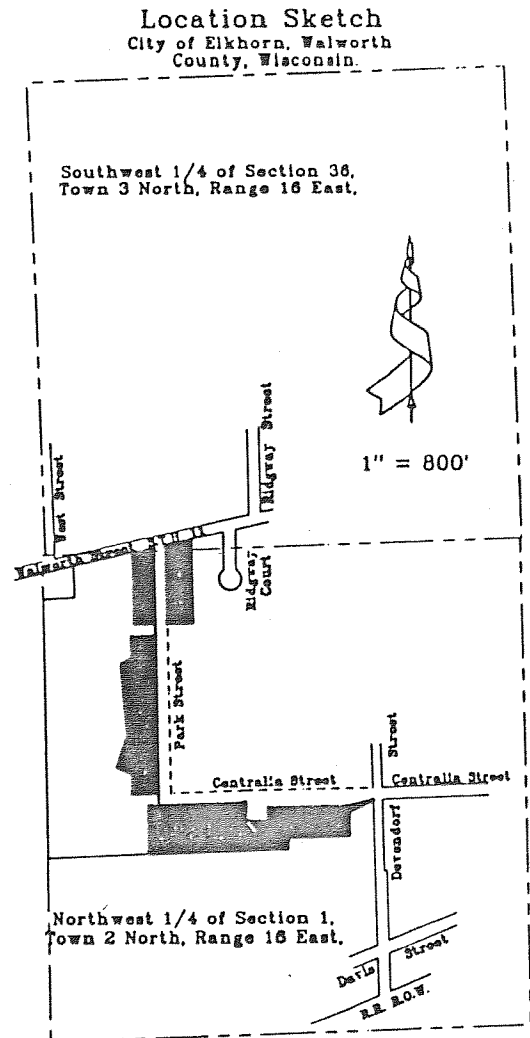
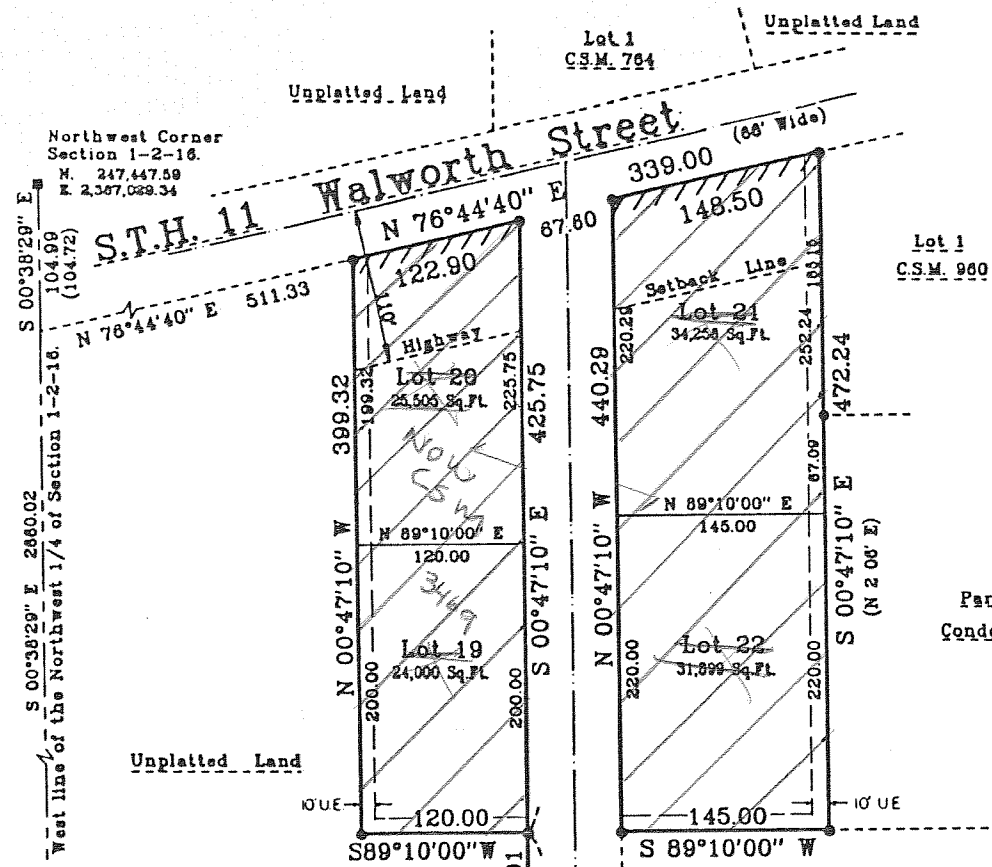


# Alder Subdivision

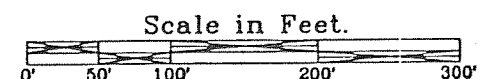

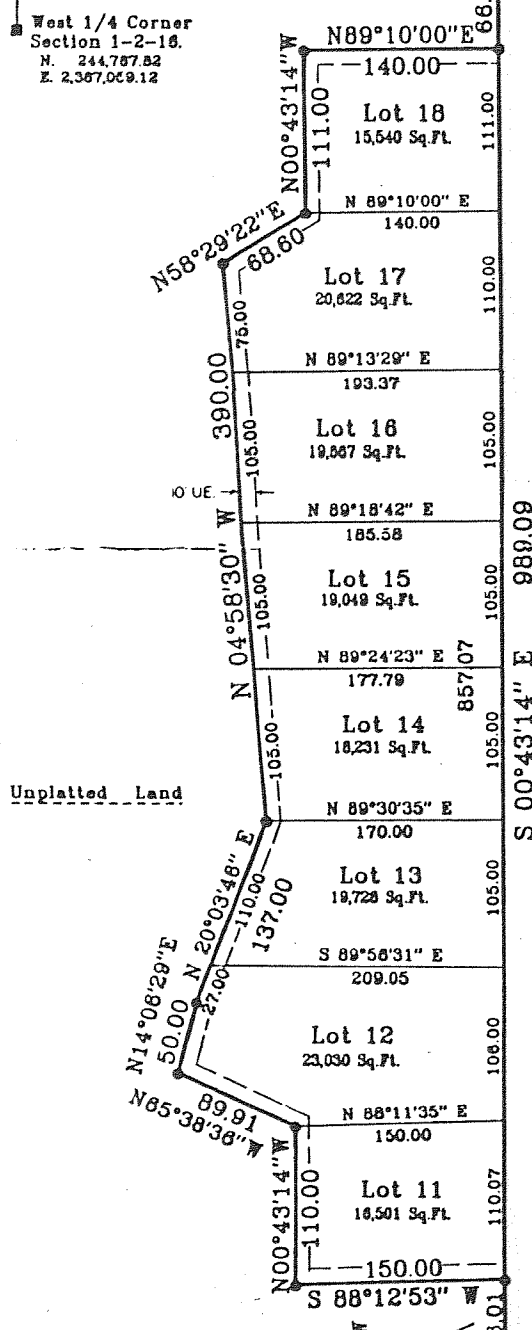
- As owner I hereby restrict all lots and blocks, in that no owner, possessor, user, nor licensee, nor any other person shall have any right of direct vehicular ingress or egress with STH 11 or Walworth Street, as shown on the plat, it being expressly intended that this restriction shall constitute a restriction for the benefit of the public according to section 236.293, Wisconsin Statutes and shall be enforceable by the Department of Transportation.
- No improvements or structures are allowed between the right-of-way and the setback line. Improvements include but are not limited to signs, parking lots, parallel driveways, walls, septic systems, drainage facilities, etc. It being expressly intended that this restriction shall constitute a restriction for the benefit of the public according to section 236.293, Wisconsin Statutes and shall be enforceable by the Department of Transportation. 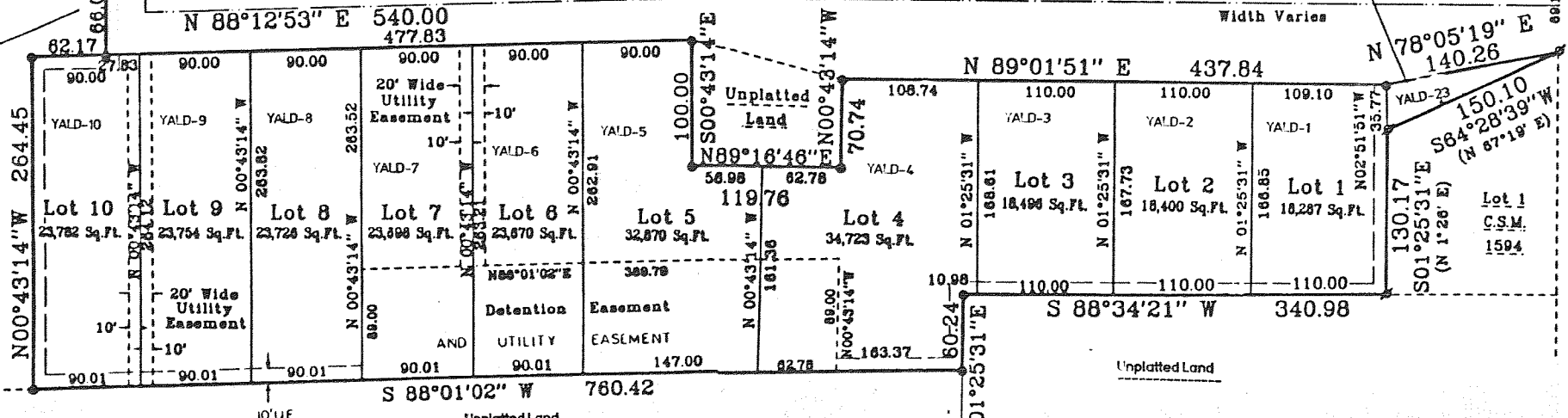
- Found County Section Corner, Concrete Monument With Brass Cap
