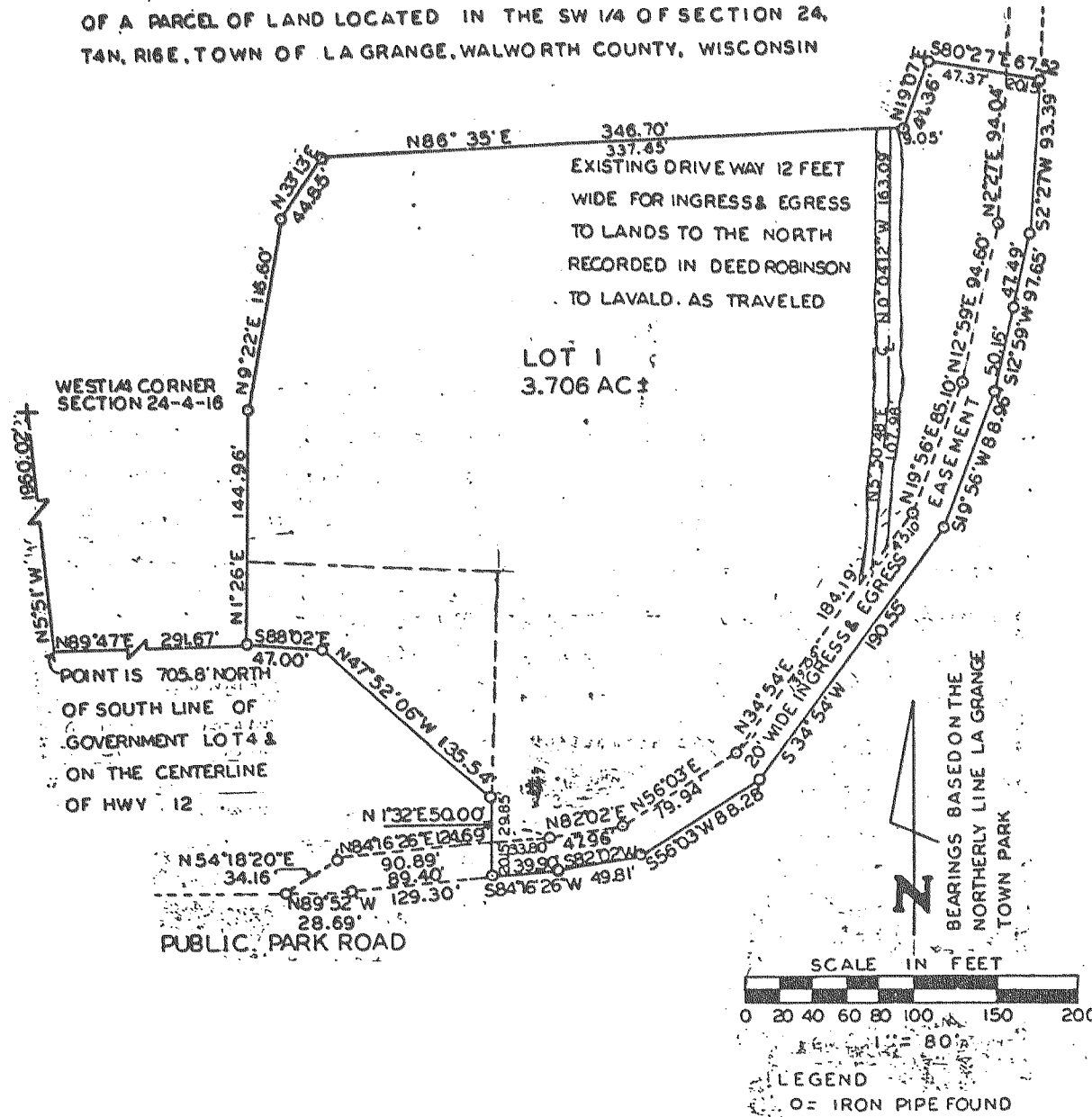

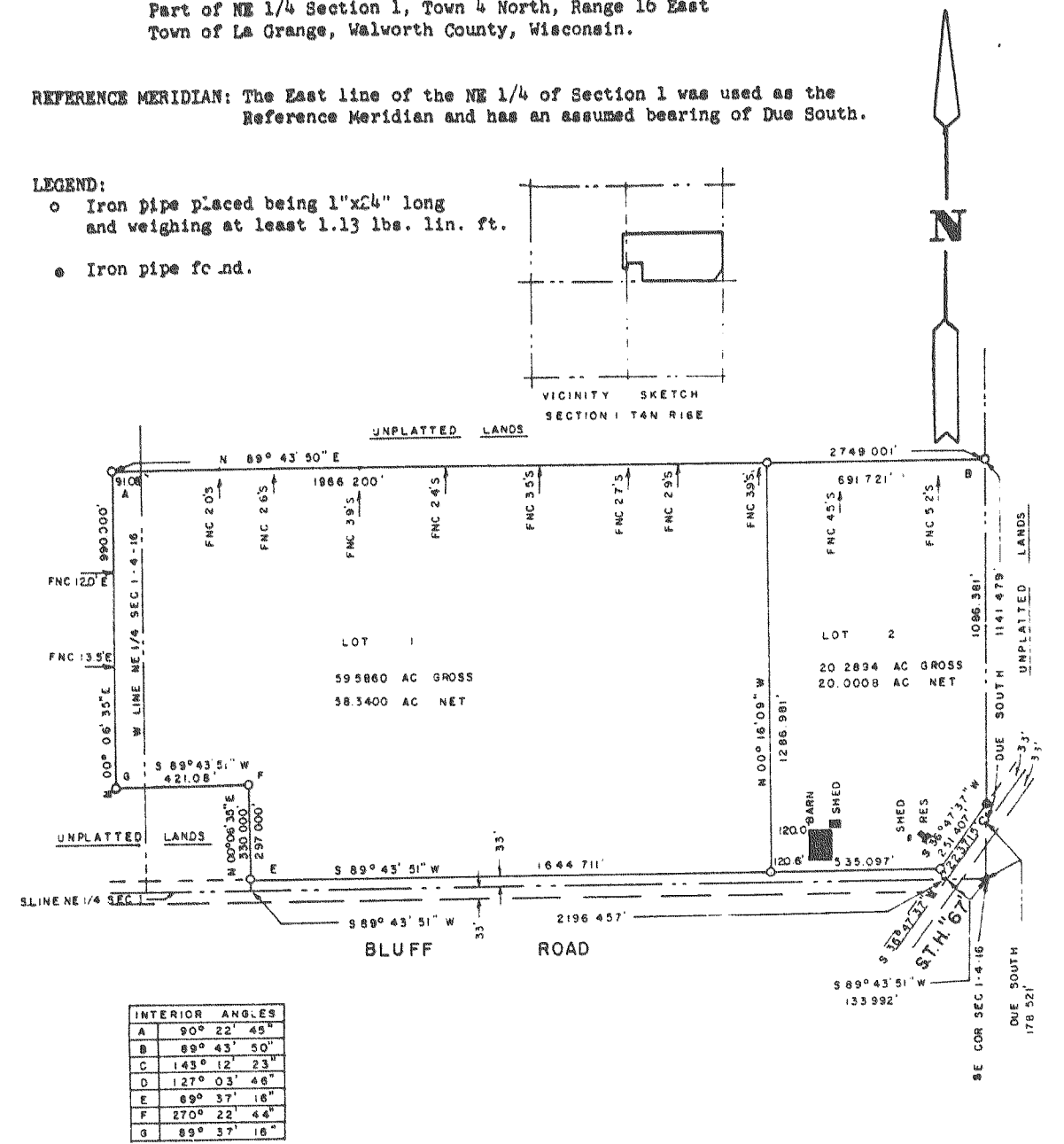
CERTIFIED SURVEY MAP NO. 1043

 Reference Meridian and has an assumed bearing of Due South.

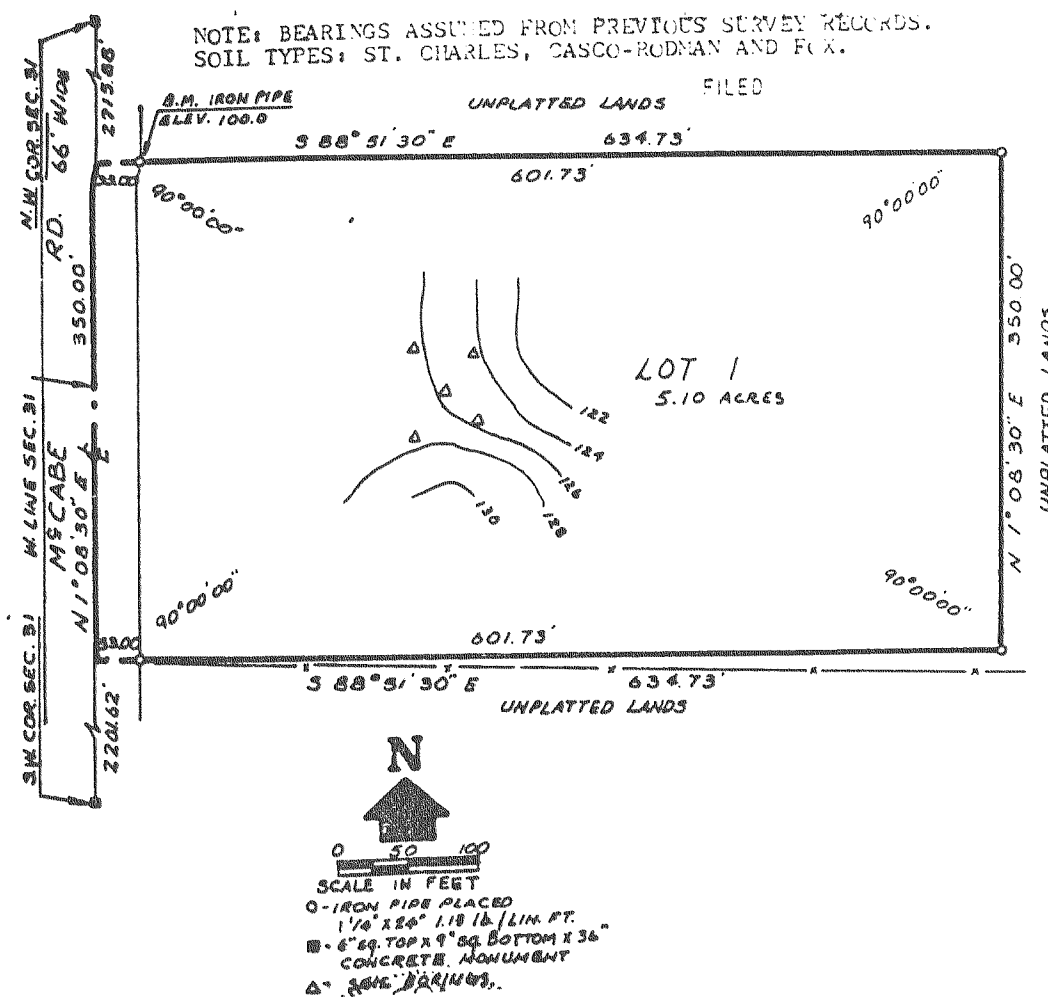
