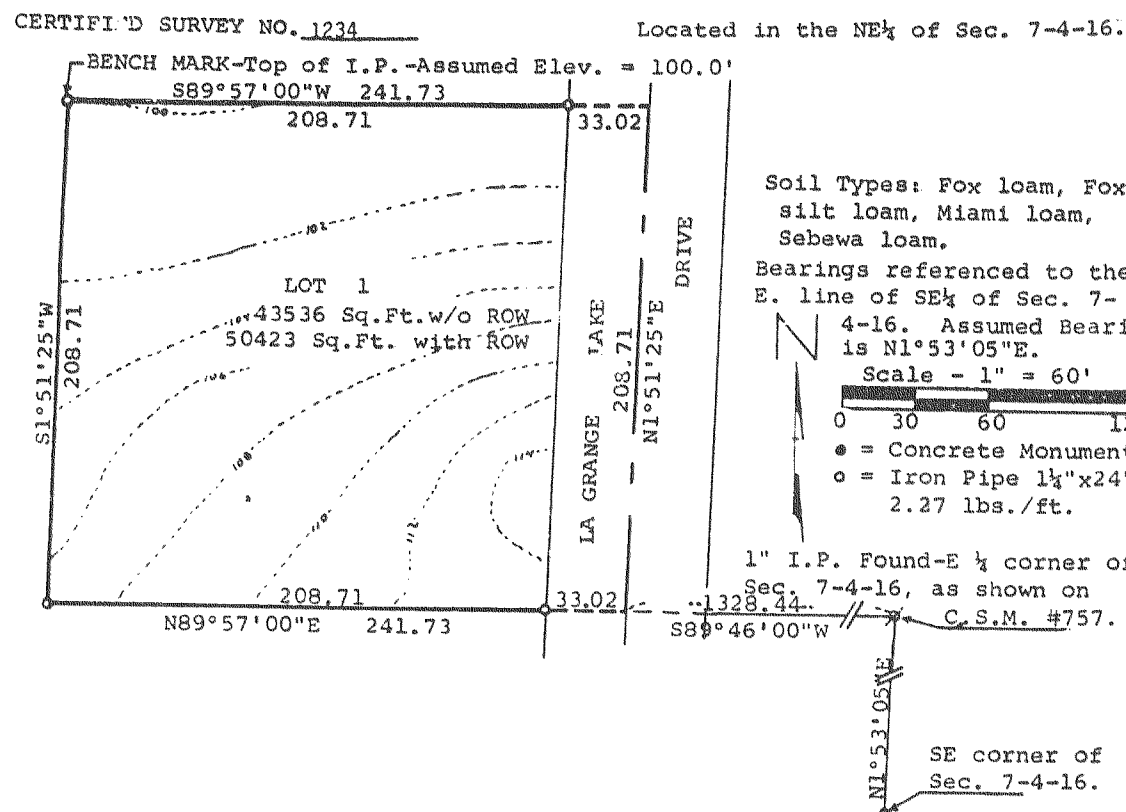
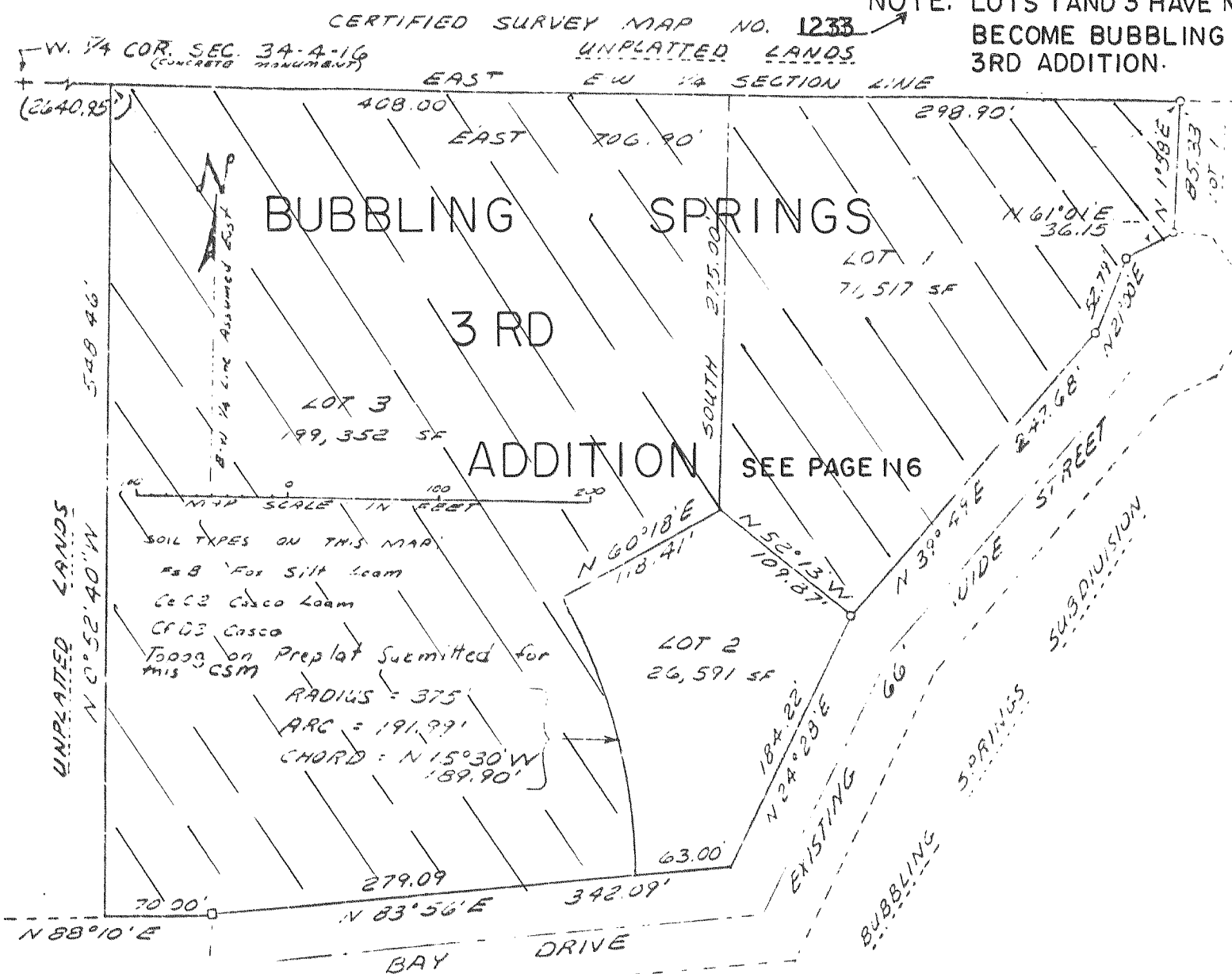

3RD ADDITION.



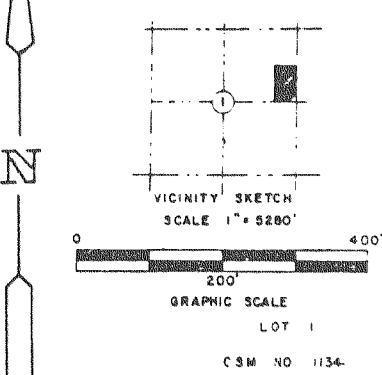

REFERENCE MERIDIAN: The East line of the NE 1/4 of Section 1 was used as the Reference Meridian and has an assumed bearing of Due South.

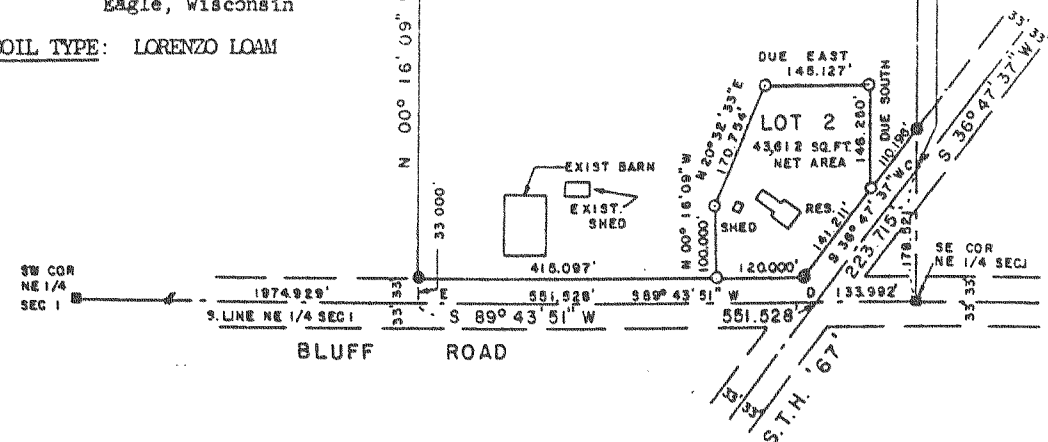

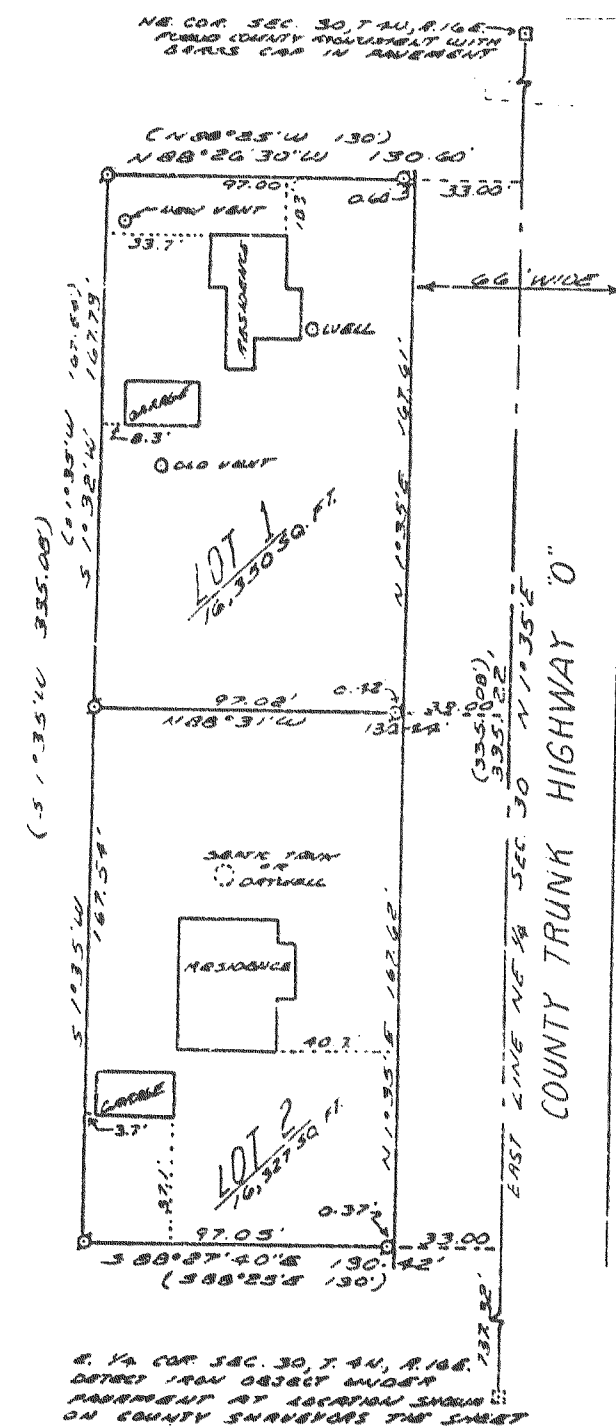
