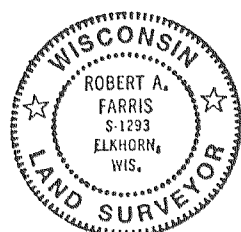
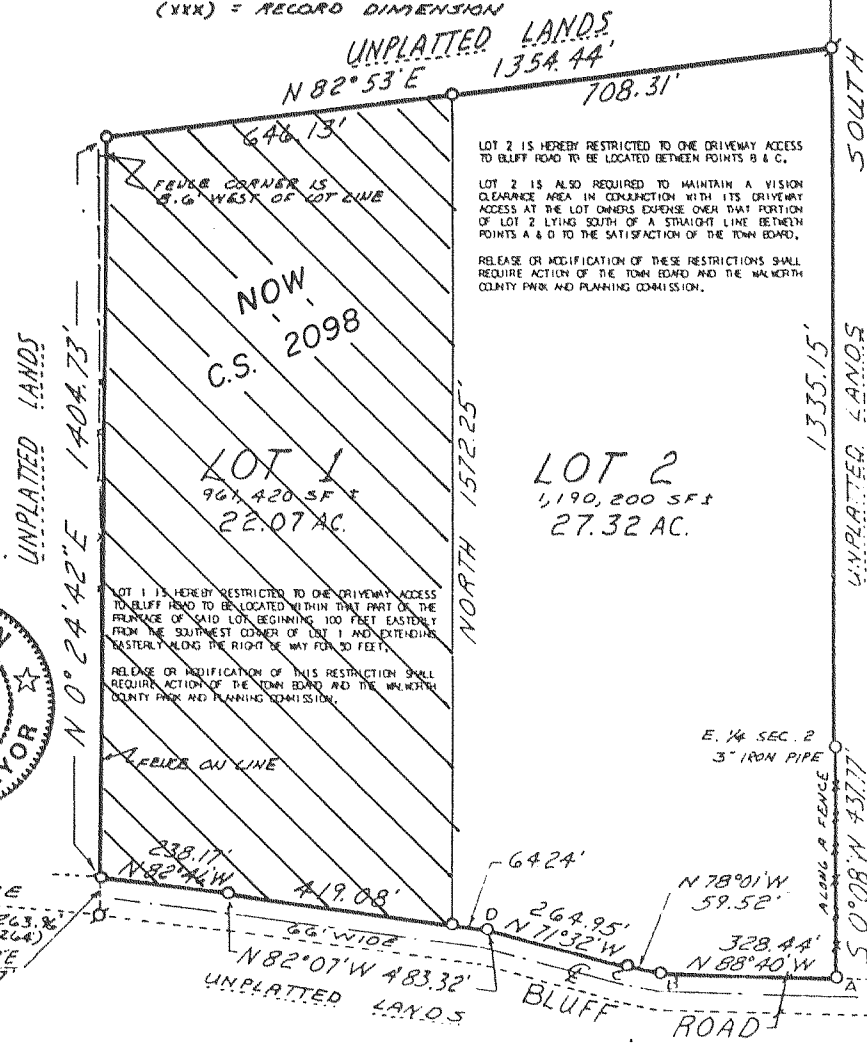

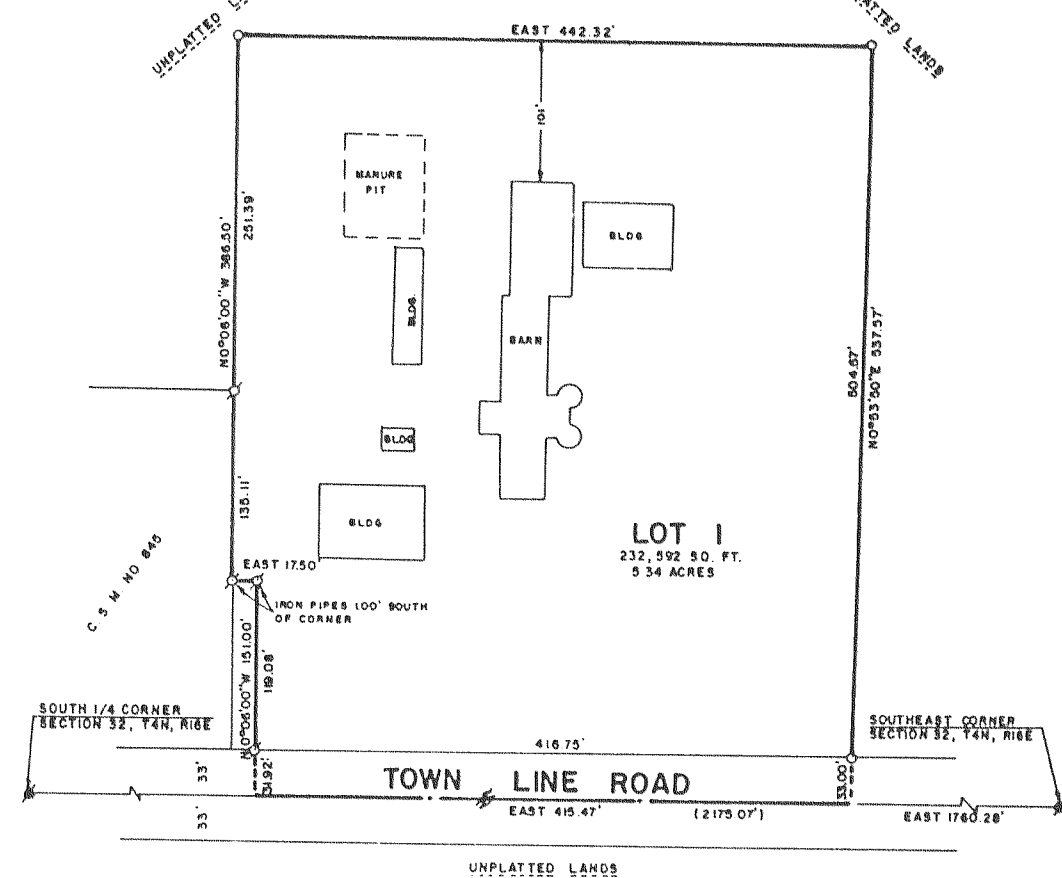

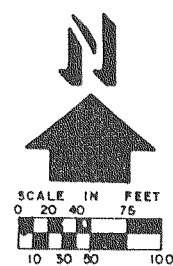

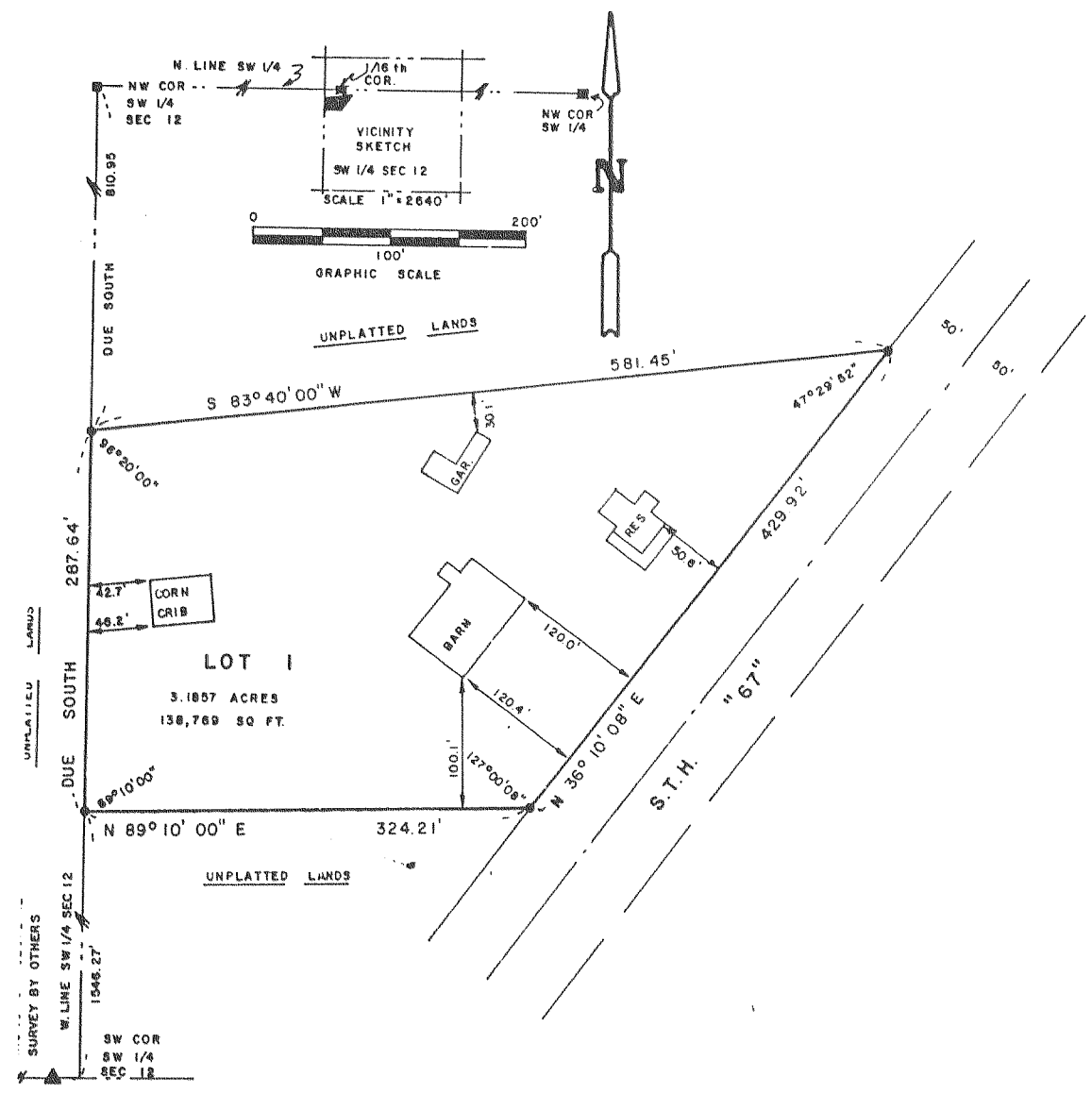

REFERENCE MERIDIAN: The west line of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 12 was used as the Reference Meridian and has as assumed bearing of Due South.

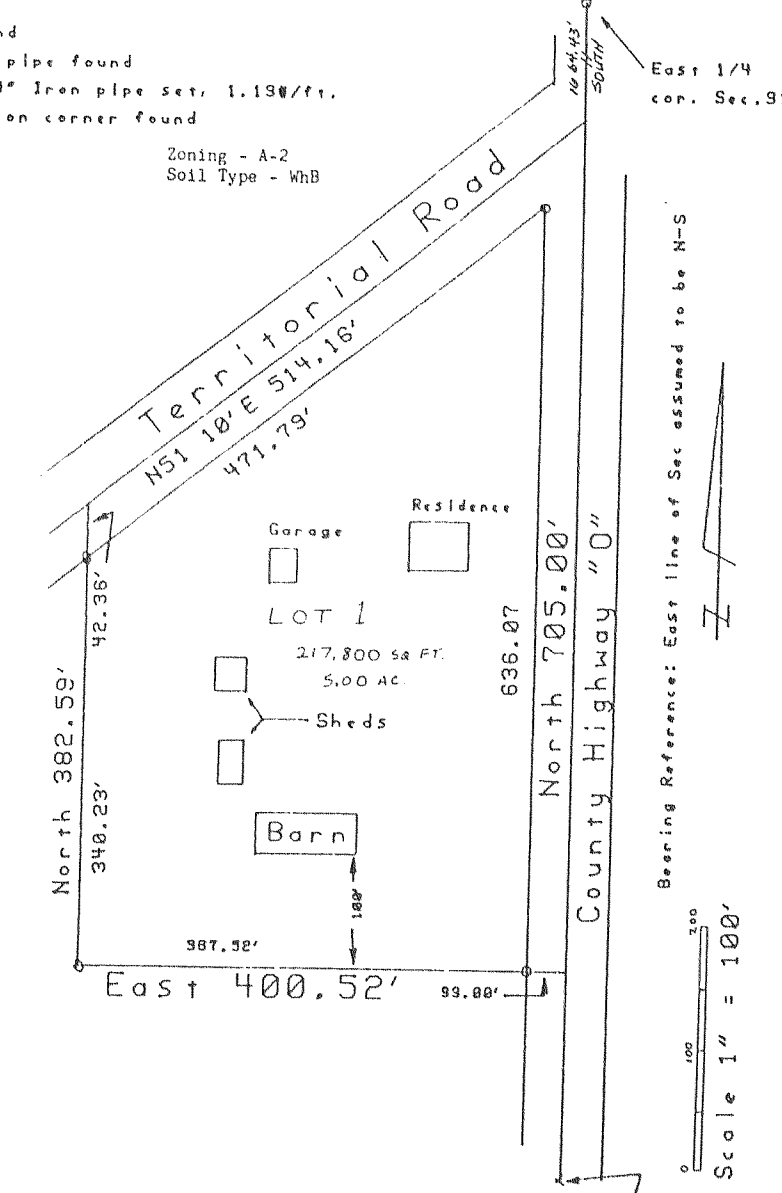
