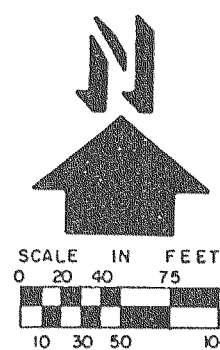
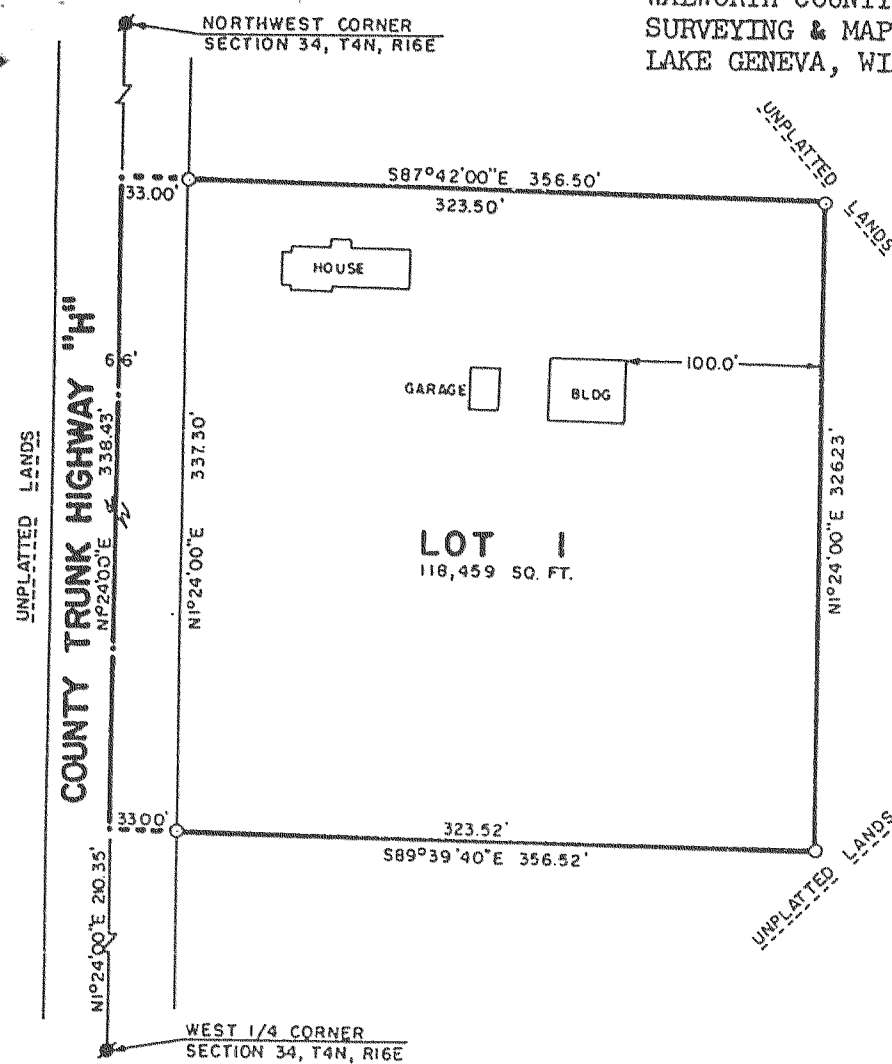

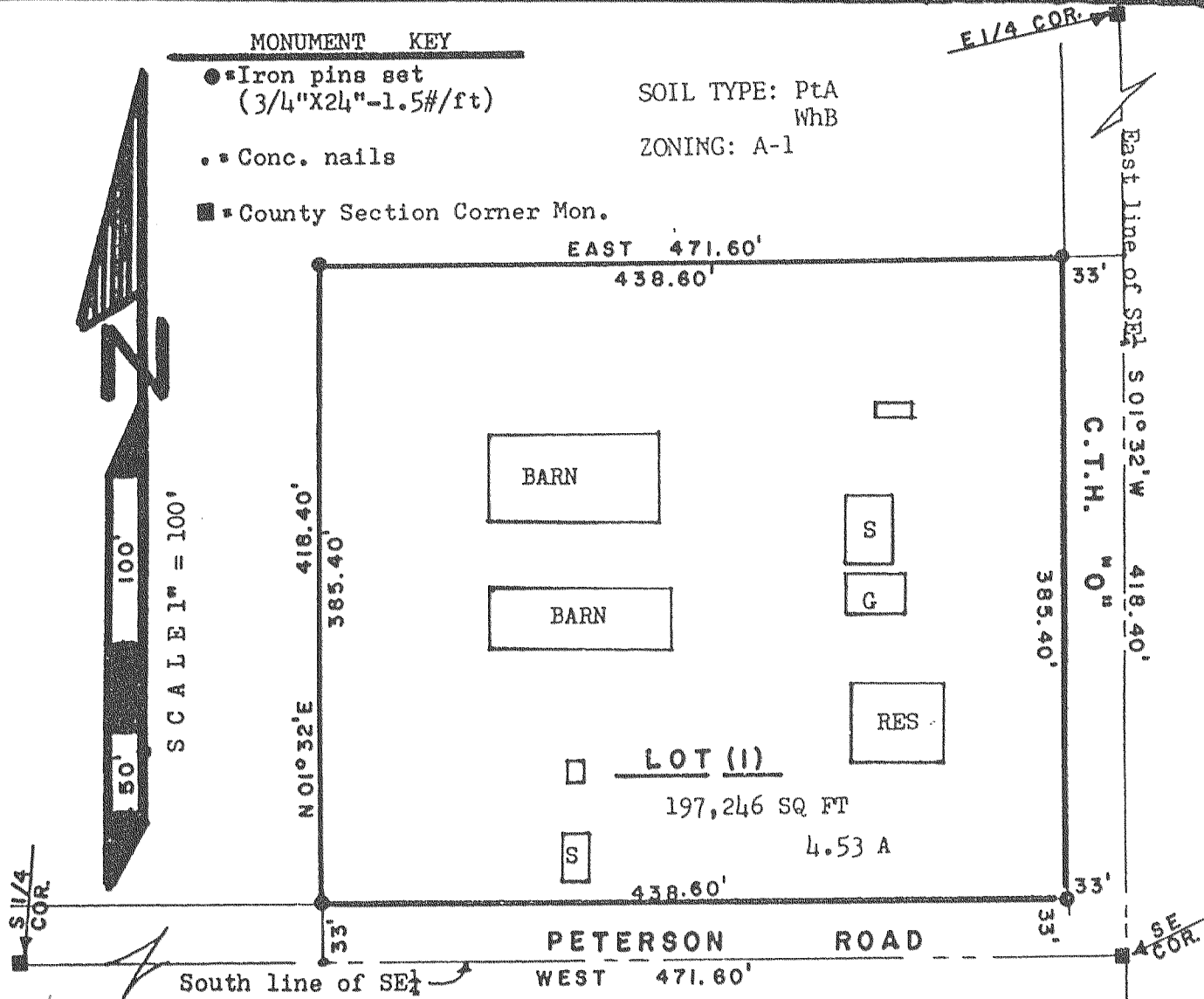
SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE:

BAERENWALD, REGISTERED LAND SURVEYOR, HEREBY CERTIFY THAT IN FULL COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 236.34 OF THE WISCONSIN STATUTES AND THE LAND DIVISION (SUBDIVISION) ORDINANCE OF WALWORTH COUNTY, AND UNDER THE DIRECTION OF LYLE FELL, AN OWNER OF SAID LAND, I HAVE SURVEYED, DIVIDED AND MAPPED THIS CERTIFIED SURVEY, THAT SUCH PLAT REPRESENTS ALL EXTERIOR BOUNDARIES AND THE SUBDIVISION OF THE LAND SURVEYED AND THAT THIS LAND IS LOCATED IN THE SOUTHWEST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 34, T 4 N, R 16 E, WALWORTH COUNTY, WISCONSIN AND DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: COMMENCING AT THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SAID SECTION 34, THENCE N1°24'00"E 210.35 FEET TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING; THENCE N1°24'00"E 338.43 FEET; THENCE S87°42'00"E 356.50 FEET; THENCE S1°24'00"W 326.23 FEET; THENCE N89°39'40"W 356.52 FEET TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING 2.72 ACRES OF LAND.

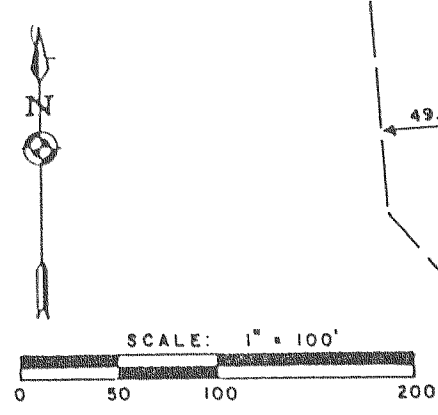

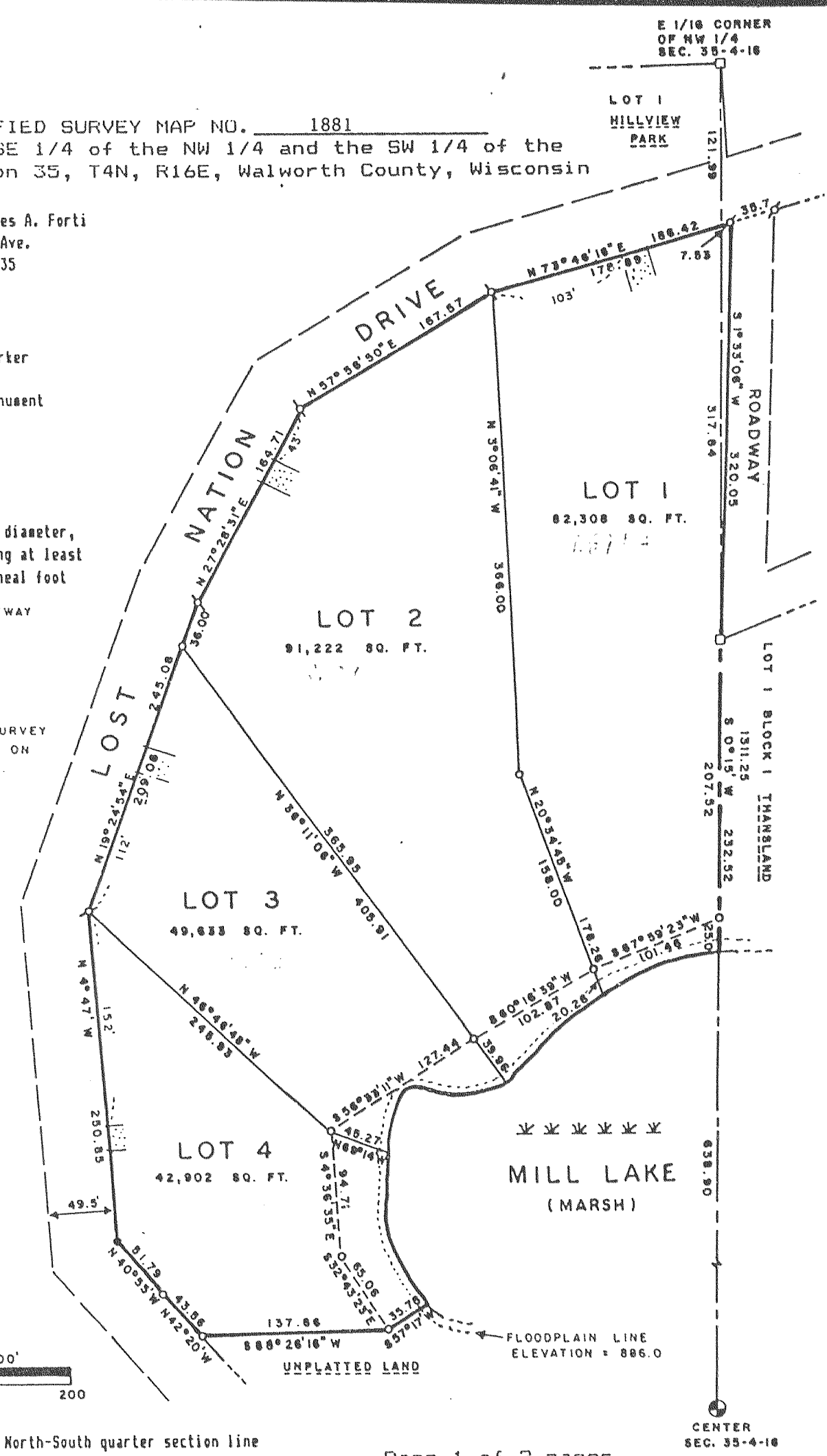
