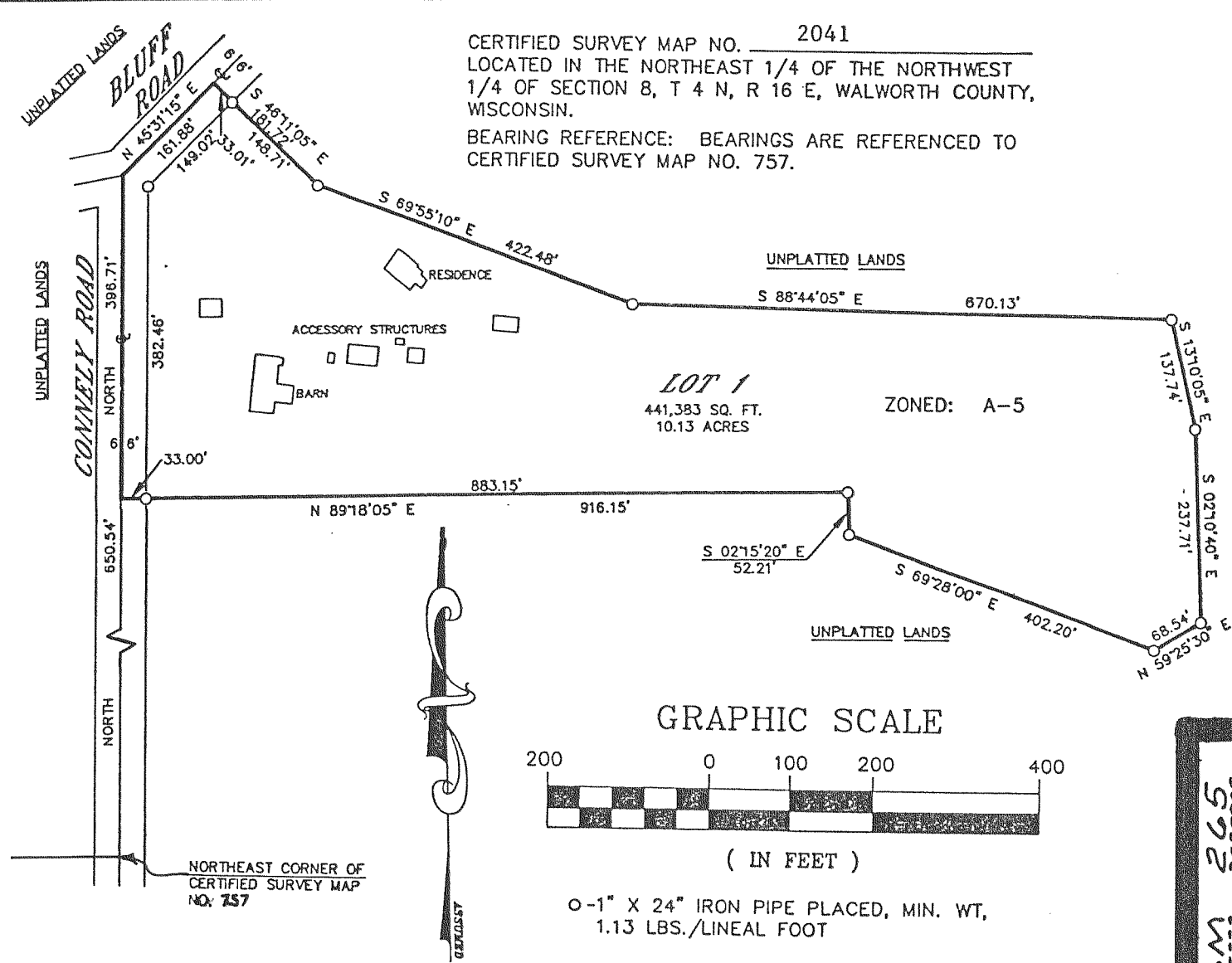


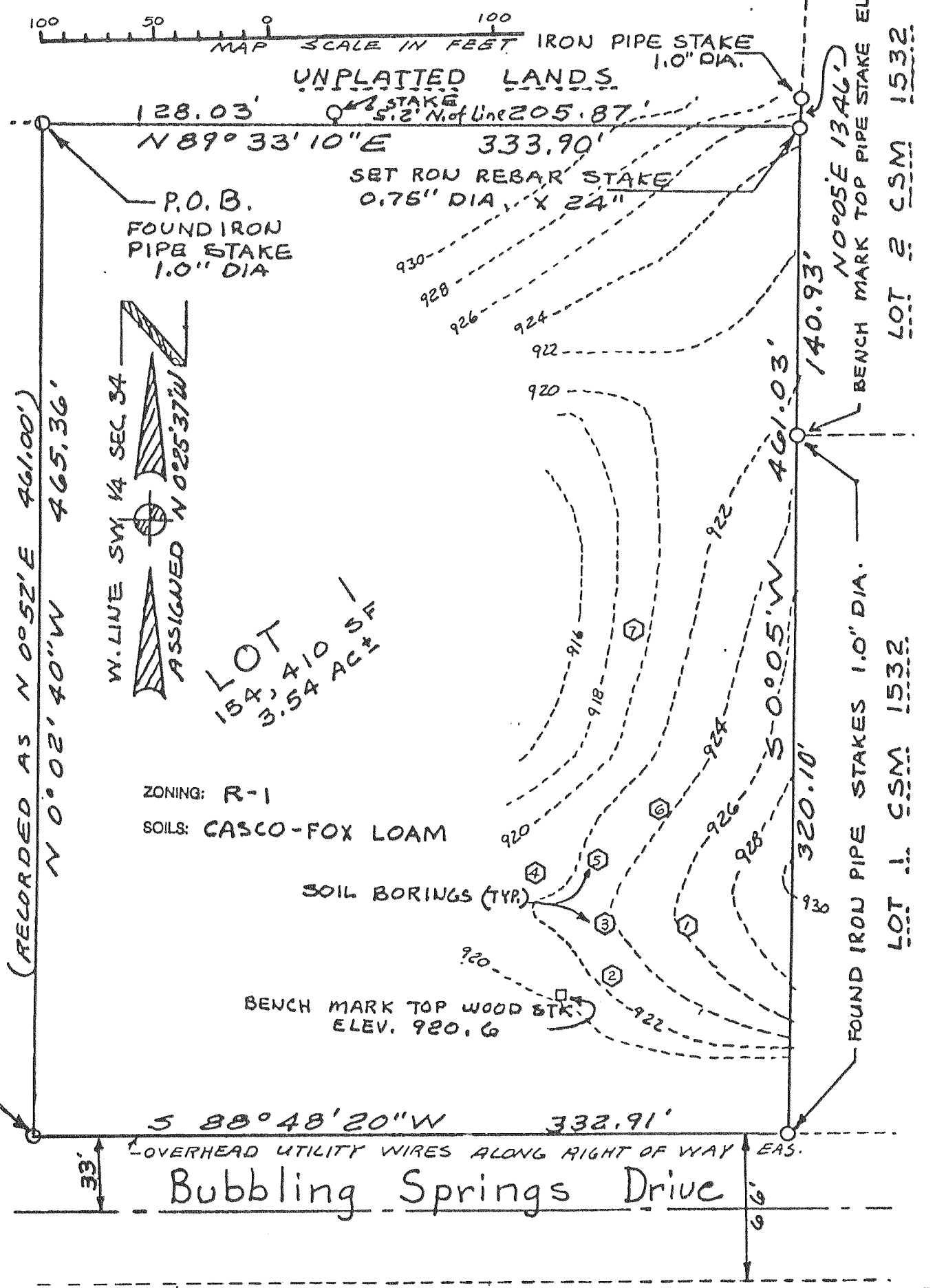

SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE:
 I, ROBERT M. BAERENWALD, REGISTERED LAND SURVEYOR, HEREBY CERTIFY THAT IN FULL COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 236.34 OF THE WISCONSIN STATUTES AND THE LAND DIVISION ORDINANCE OF WALWORTH COUNTY, AND UNDER THE DIRECTION OF DENNIS KNUTESON, AN OWNER OF SAID LAND, I HAVE SURVEYED, DIVIDED AND MAPPED THIS CERTIFIED SURVEY, THAT SUCH PLAT CORRECTLY REPRESENTS ALL EXTERIOR BOUNDARIES AND THE SUBDIVISION OF THE LAND SURVEYED AND THAT THIS LAND IS LOCATED IN THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 8, T 4 N, R 16 E, WALWORTH COUNTY, WISCONSIN, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: COMMENCING AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF CERTIFIED SURVEY MAP NO. 757, THENCE NORTH 650.54 FEET TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING; THENCE CONTINUE NORTH 396.71 FEET; THENCE N45°31'15"E 161.88 FEET; THENCE S69°55'10"E 422.48 FEET; THENCE S88°44'05"E 670.13 FEET; THENCE S13°10'05"E 137.74 FEET; THENCE S2°10'40"E 237.71 FEET; THENCE S59°25'30"W 68.54 FEET; THENCE N69°28'00"W 402.20 FEET; THENCE N2°15'20"W 52.21 FEET; THENCE S89°18'05"W 916.15 FEET TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING 10.13 ACRES OF LAND.

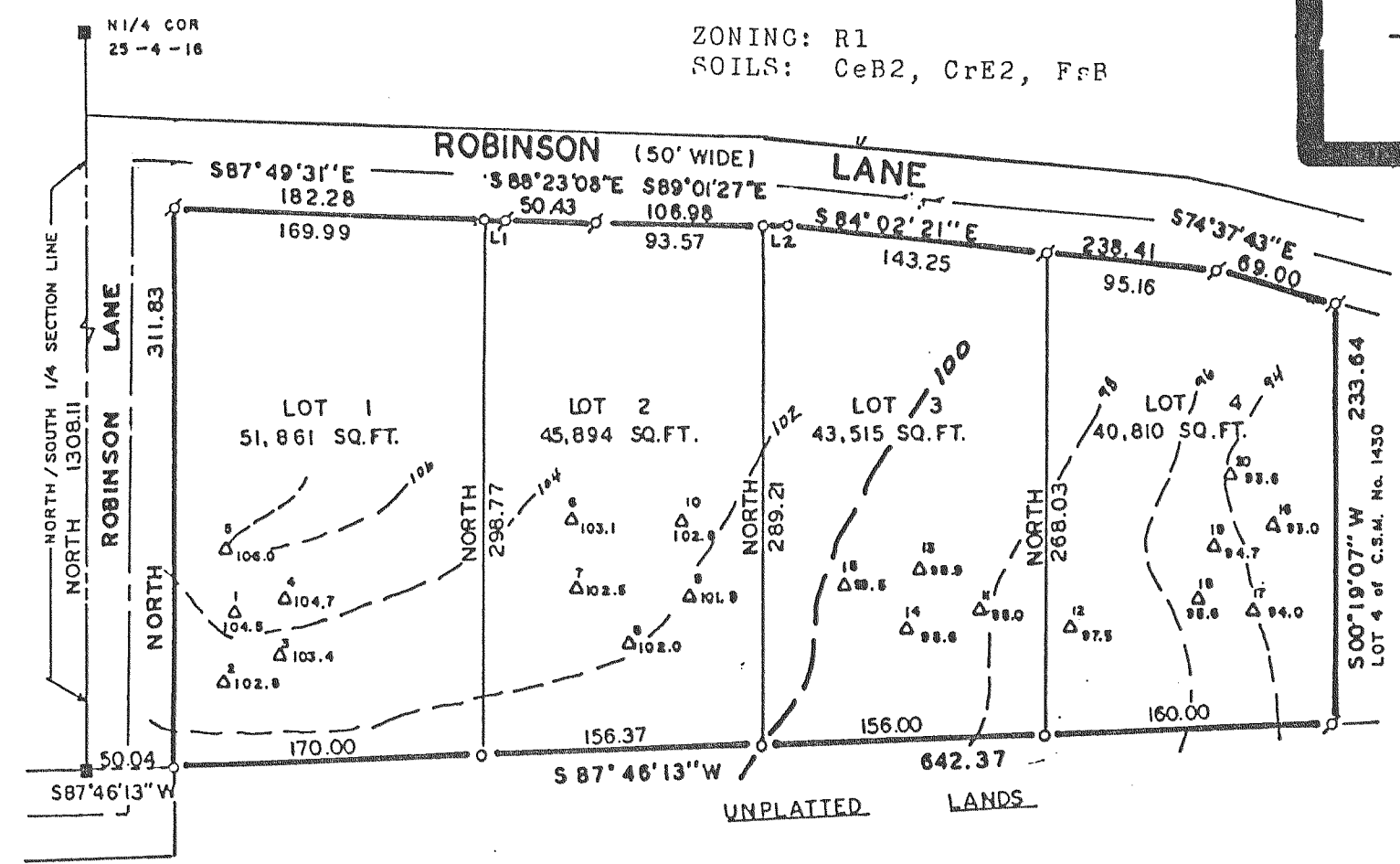

A parcel of land located in Government Lot 2, Section 25, Town 4 North, Range 16 East, Town of Lagrange, Walworth County, Wisconsin.

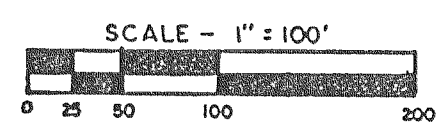
