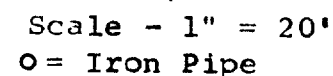


**SURVEYING & SUBDIVIDING
DELA VAN, WISCONSIN 53115**



A parcel of land located in a part of Outlot 1 of the Original Plat of the Village (now City) of Delavan, Walworth County, Wisconsin, described as follows: Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 7, Block 2 of Sarah A. Phoenix Addition to the City of Delavan; thence Northerly along the west line of said Block 2, 186.34 feet; thence Westerly 165.17 feet to a point on the east line of Third Street located 346.50 feet south of the intersection of the south line of Geneva Street and the east line of Third Street; thence Southerly along the east line of said Third Street 78.06 feet to a point located 108.49 feet north of the north line of Phoenix Street and which point was formerly the centerline of a drainage ditch; thence Southeasterly 197.30 feet to the place of beginning, which last described line is along the centerline of said ~~former~~ drainage ditch.
