

The northerly 100.25 feet of Lot 1, Block 7, Passage, Aram & Downie Addition to the City of Delavan, Walworth County, Wisconsin, EXCEPTING THEREFROM, the following portion of said Lot 1: Beginning at a point on the north line of said Lot 1 located 43.49 feet east of the northwest corner of said Lot 1; thence East along the north line of said Lot 1, 56.00 feet to the northeast corner of said Lot 1; thence S0°13'W along the east line of said Lot 1, 28.00 feet; thence N49°59'W 32.31 feet; thence N77°00'W 32.00 feet to the place of beginning. (Said exception is erroneously described in the deed recorded in Volume 291 of Records, Page 504, January 12, 1982, Arthur L. and Kathryn S. Johnson to City of Delavan, being described as follows: Commencing at the West 1 corner of Section 17; thence S6°44'E 45.5 feet to a point on the north line of Block 7 in Passage, Aram & Downie Addition to the City of Delavan; which is the point of beginning of said parcel; thence continue along the north line of Passage, Aram, & Downie Addition 56.00 feet to the northeast corner of said Block 7; thence South along the east line of Passage, Aram, & Downie Addition 28.00 feet to a point; thence Northwesterly 33.27 feet along a curve with a radius of 41 feet to a point; which is the end of said curve; thence N75°30'W 32.00 feet to a point of beginning; thence N6°44'W 45.5 feet to the West & corner of Section 17 and the end of this
