

Phoenix Addition to the City of Delavan; thence N89°23'30"E on the south line of said Lot 8, 165.00 feet; thence S0°02'00"E along the west line of Knapp's Subdivision, 112.68 feet; thence S88°30°30"W parallel with the north line of Phoenix Street 65.40 feet; thence NO°07'00"E parallel with the east line of Fourth Street 9.00 feet; thence S88°30'30"W parallel with the north line of Phoenix Street 100.00 feet; thence N0°07'00"E along the east line of Fourth Street 106.30 feet to the place of beginning.

Parcel 2 - A parcel of land located in the Southeast & of Section 18, T 2 N, R 16 E, City of Delavan, Walworth County, Wisconsin, described as follows: Commencing at the intersection of the north line of Phoenix Street and the east line of Fourth Street; thence NO°07°00"E along the east line of Fourth Street 116.00 feet to the place of beginning; thence continue NO°07'00"E along the east line of Fourth Street 70.00 feet; thence N88°30°30"E parallel with the north line of Phoenix Street 100.00 feet; thence S0°07'00"W 9.00 feet; thence N88°30'30"E parallel with the north line of Phoenix Street 65.40 feet to the west line of Knapp's Subdivision; thence S0°02'00"E along the west line of Knapp's Subdivision 61.00 feet to a point located 116.00 feet north of the north line of Phoenix Street; thence \$88°30'30"W 165.52 feet to the east line of Fourth Street and the place of beginning.
