



All that certain piece or parcel of land lying and being in the Southwest Quarter of Section 20, Township 4, North, Range 18 East, and being also in the Village of East Troy, Walworth County, Wisconsin and more fully described as follows: Beginning at the Northerly corner of Lot 1, Block 13 of the recorded plat of the Original Village of East Troy; thence Southeasterly along the Northeasterly side of said Lot 1, 9.4 feet to an iron stake, thence East 172 feet to an iron stake that is 75 feet West (measuring at right angles to) the East line of lands of Gotlieb C. Kuhl Estate; thence North parallel with and 75 faet West of the above mentioned East line 117.4 Tet to an iron stake on the Southeasterly side of the Milwaukee & Beloit Territorial Road, new known as Main Street in said Village of East Troy, thence Southwesterly along the Southeasterly side of said road or street of an acre of land.
