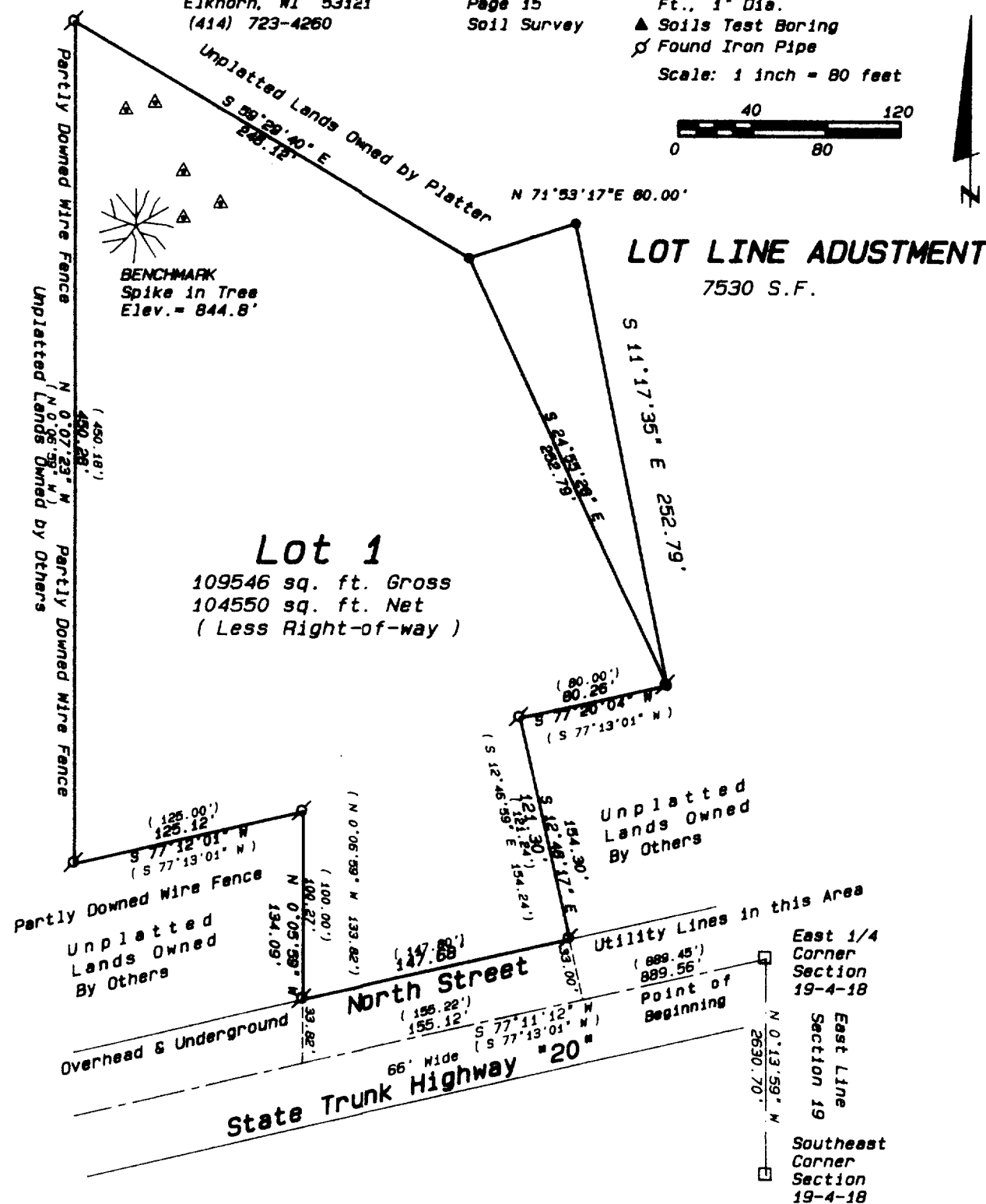

## LEGAL DESCRIPTION FOR LOT LINE ADJUSTMENT:

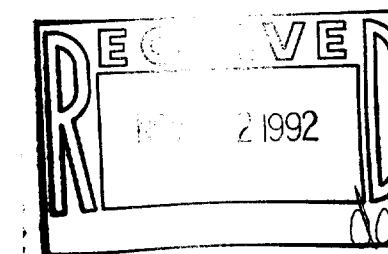
A parcel of land located in part of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 and part of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 19, Town 4 North, Range 18 East, Village of East Troy, County of Walworth, State of Wisconsin, described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the East 1/4 Corner of said Section 19; thence S 77°11'12" W along the centerline of State Trunk Highway "20" and North Street 889.56 feet (recorded as S 77°13'01" W 889.45 feet); thence N 12°48'17" W along the easterly line of Certified Survey Map No. 2174 as recorded in Vol. 10 of Walworth County Certified Survey Maps on Pages 243 and 244 as Document no. 237355, 121.30 feet to a Found Iron Pipe; thence N 77°20'04" E along the southerly line of said Certified Survey Map 80.26 feet to a Found Iron Rod and the point of beginning; thence N 24°55'28" W along the easterly line of said Certified Survey Map 252.79 feet to a Found Iron Pipe; thence N 71°53'17" E 60.00 feet to a Set Iron Rod; thence S 11°17'35" E 252.79 feet to the point of beginning. The above described parcel is a lot line adjustment between adjoining owners of land and contains 0.17 acres of land more or less.

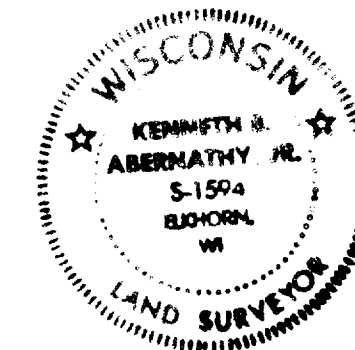
