



DESCRIPTION:

Commencing at the southwest corner of South Street and Church Street in the Village of East Troy, Walworth County, Wisconsin, thence South 264.0 feet along the west line of said Church Street, to an iron stake, thence 141.59 feet S. 12° E., along the westerly line of said Church Street to the place of beginning of this description; thence 146.96 feet S. 12° E. along the westerly line of said Church Street to an iron stake the point of curve of a 30.0 feet radius curve, thence 53.38 feet, convex southwesterly along the arc of a 30.0 feet curve to an iron stake the point of tangent of said curve, thence west 130.65 feet to an iron stake, thence north 180.0 feet to an iron stake, thence east 129.44 feet to the place of beginning.
