
PLAT OF SURVEY

Parcel 1: As recorded in Volume 54, Page 824 at the Register of Deeds Office for Walworth County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the Northeast corner of Do-Rae Heights Subdivision for the point of beginning for this description; thence S 89°-05'-36" E, 85.01 feet; thence N 00°-56'-20" E, 207.28 feet to the Southerly right-of-way of State Highway "20"; thence S 78°-18'-53" W, along said right-of-way 87.12 feet; thence S 00°-56'-20" W, 188.32 feet to the place of beginning containing 0.386+ acres.

Parcel 2: As recorded in Volume 523, Page 51 at the Register of Deeds Office for Walworth County, Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the Northeast corner of Do-Rae Heights Subdivision for the point of beginning for this description; thence N 00°-56'-20" E, 188.32 feet to the Southerly right-of-way of State Highway "20"; thence S 78°-05'-43" W, along said right-of-way, 67.51 feet; thence S 00°-59'-49" W, 172.63 feet to the North line of Do-Rae Heights Subdivision; thence S 88°-30'-00" E, along said North line, 66.00 feet to the point of beginning containing 0.273+ acres.
