

## DESCRIPTION:

Commencing at an iron stake on the east line of Lot 5, Block 20, of the Original Plat of the Village (now city) of Elkhorn, Walworth County, Wisconsin, that is  $2\frac{1}{2}$  feet south of the **northeast** corner of said Lot 5, thence North on the west line of Washington Street, 73.0 feet to an iron stake, thence west 65.45 feet to an iron stake, thence South 73.0 feet to an iron stake, thence East 65.45 feet to the place of beginning. Being  $70\frac{1}{2}$  feet off the south side of Lot 4 in said Block 20 and  $2\frac{1}{2}$  feet off the north side of the said Lot 5; excepting therefrom the West 68.0 feet thereof.
