With your pleasure sir, for the Lake Geneva Sanitariums
the said wife Dotti & Company had given me two blue prints
the following is the description which I copy from one
of the original record of land surveying at a point, in the West Line
of Block Thirty-Four (34) west of the Village of Geneva (now
the Town of Geneva) according to the survey and plat of
the same record in the office of the Register of
Deeds of Walworth County, Walworth, One Hundred-
Twenty-Four (124) feet South of the South
line of the said Block, and being the South-
west corner of the lands in the said line of lands
belonging to the said wife Dotti & Company, deceased
and her husband, the late Mr. John Baker, deceased
and being the South-west corner of the said line; thence North
forty-five degrees and one-quarter (45 1/4) feet in the South line of the
said lands to a cut stone
monument set in the top, in the first line of the
said lands, and being the South-west corner of the lands
owned by the said Lake Geneva Sanitariums, formally the
Woodlawn Retirement Association; thence North -Seventy-aadd
degrees (70 1/4) East in the South line of
the said lands owned by the said first party to an angle
thereat is placed a stone monument; thence East in the
South line of the said lands Eighty-three and three-fourths
(83 3/4) square feet to a stone monument which stands
in the aforesaid West line of the said Block Thirty-four
(34); thence South in the said West line of Block Thirty-
Four (34) Sixty-five and one-quarter (65 1/4) feet to
the place of commencement, meaning and intending hereby
to convey the land described in deed from Luella W.
Baker to Lake Geneva Sanitariums dated June 25th. 1910 in
