SURVEYOR'S CERTIFICATE.

This is to certify that by request of Henry Kinnell and Anton Holtzemer we have made a careful survey of the line between said Holtzemer's lot and the lots owned by Deacon Rich, and also by Phillip Kinnell to the west of Holtzemer's lot. Said line purports to be the line between Lot 46 on the east and lots 46 & 47 on the west, Perigrine's ad., to Geneva Village.

By careful previous survey and a thorough search of the records we find that there is an error in length of the north line of Lot 46 as shown in original plat, viz 87' ft. (The dimensions of lots 47 & 4 are not given on original plat.)

As the property has been deeded from original owners from the N. line of lot 46 it is shown to be and measures only 125 ft. or 117.5 ft. to the wall on east side of Filbert's St. This wall approaches the property line as it extends south.

It concluded 125 ft. west from the east line of Jacob Hale's lot as set by previous survey, measuring from the N.W. and S.E. corners of Hale's lot and with transit run line of over those two points and extended it to N. line of North St. for the line to be surveyed. Iron stakes were set at both ends of this line and for Phillip Kinnell's C.R. cor. at the midpoint of this line as shown in his deed, said midpoint is 145.5 ft. from each end of said line.
