Description of a survey made for John Farber of land sold by him to---

Begin at an iron stake in the North line of Kohn's Subdivision in the City of Lake Geneva, Wis., 180 ft. west of the Northeast corner of said Subdivision; thence west in said north line 150 ft. to an iron stake; thence north 139 feet to an iron stake; thence east 150 ft. (in the south line of land formerly owned by A.A. Wamboldt) to an iron stake; thence south 69½ feet to an iron stake; thence south 69½ ft. to the place of beginning. The same contains 48/100 acres more or less.

The above is one half of the lot described in John Farber's deed west of the west line of Williams St. His lot extends to the center of Williams St. but he says he sold one half the usable land.
