The West line, which is the boundary line between the said Forter property and the Lake Ceneva Manor a subdivision formerly owned by L.Z.Leiter This line was carefully surveyed in 1926 when this Manor subdivision was proposed and found to be correct and as laid when Mr. Porter first pwned the 對抗 land.
