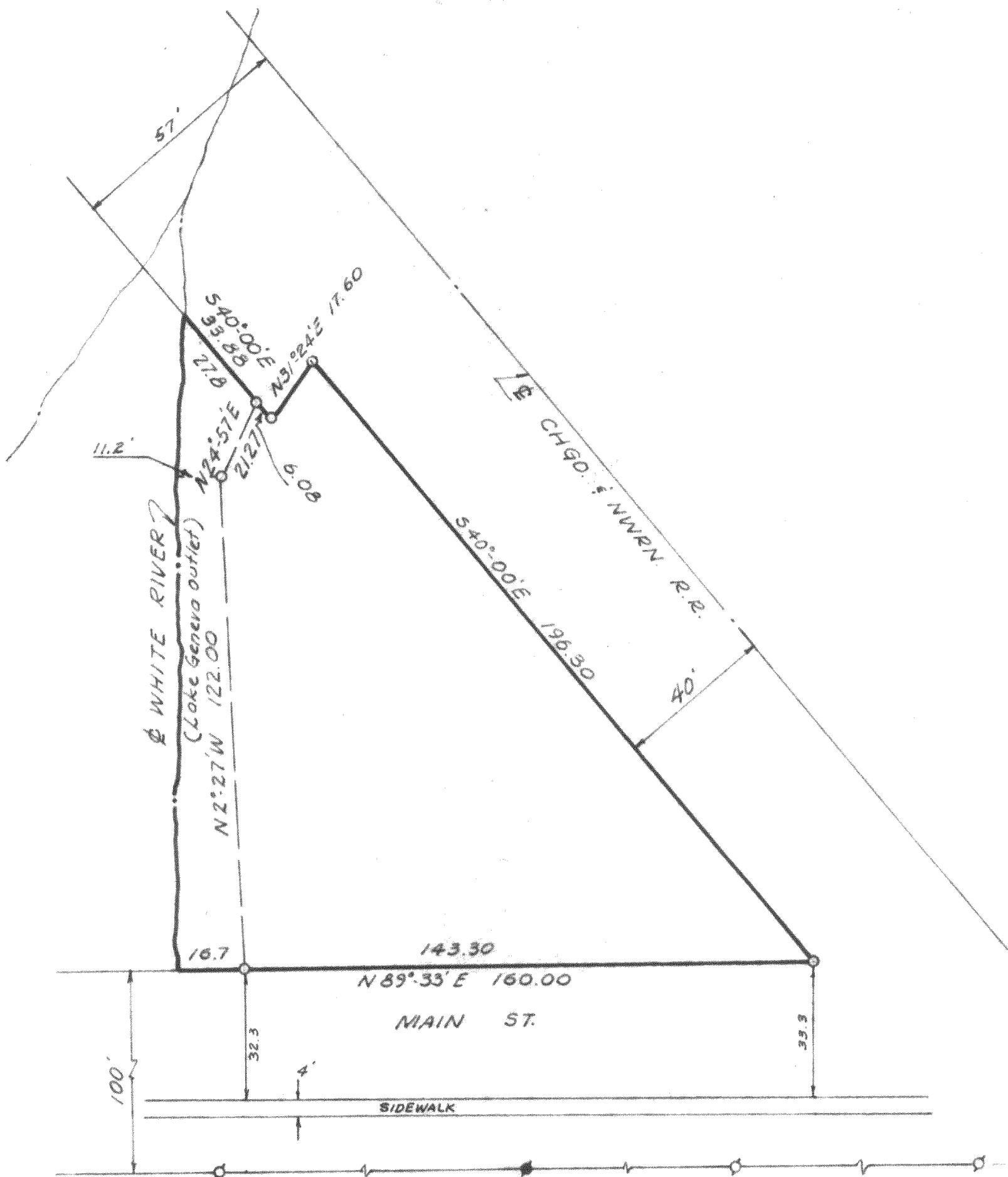

PLAT OF SURVEY OF

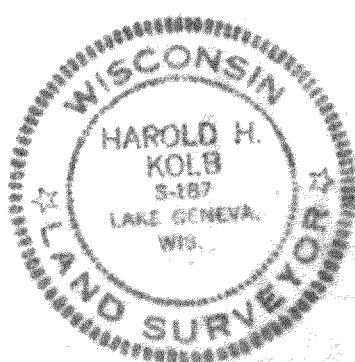
A parcel of land located in the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, T 2 N R 17 E, City of Lake Geneva, Walworth County, Wisconsin and as described in Volume 281 of Deeds, Page 177, and more particularly described as follows; to-wit: Beginning at the intersection of the Southwesterly right-of-way line of the Chicago and Northwestern Railroad and the North line of Main Street in said City of Lake Geneva, thence S 89°33' W along said North line, 160.00 feet to the centerline of the White River; thence Northerly along centerline of said White River to a point that intersects the Southwesterly right-of-way line of said Railroad; thence S 40°00' E 33.88 feet along said right-of-way; thence N 31°24' E 17.60 feet along said right-of-way; thence S 40°00' E 196.30 feet along said right-of-way to the place of beginning.
