



I hereby certify that I have surveyed the land shown hereon and that the description shown below is a correct description of the land as we found it to be staked and monumented in the field.

A parcel of land located in the East 1/2 of Section 35, T 2 N, R 17 E, City of Lake Geneva, Walworth County, Wisconsin and described as follows, to wit: Commencing at the intersection of the East line of said Section 35 and the Southerly line of Main Street; thence, as established by original survey, S 78° 30' West 494.88 feet; thence S 12° 12' E 95.95 feet to the place of beginning; thence N 12° 12' W 95.95 feet; thence S 78° 30' W 118.96 feet; thence S 14° 13' E 50.15 feet; thence S 77° 51' E 53.60 feet; thence S 19° 57' E 459.67 feet to the shore of Geneva Lake; thence Northeasterly 100 feet, more or less, along said shore to a point S 19° 09' E 388.68 feet from the place of beginning; thence N 19° 09' E 388.68 feet to the place of beginning.

ALSO an easement over and across the following described roadway, to wit: Beginning at a point in the Southerly line of Main Street of the City of Lake Geneva, Walworth County, Wisconsin, that is 580.81 feet S 78° 30' W of the point of intersection of said South line of Main Street with the East line of Section 35, T 2 N, R 17 E of the 4th P.M., thence S 14° 13' W 50.15 feet to an iron stake; thence S 78° 30' W 50.15 feet; thence N 14° 13' S 50.15 feet to the Southerly line of Main Street; thence N 78° 30' E 50.15 feet to the place of beginning.
