



A parcel of land located in Lota 19 and 20 of Block I of Crandall and Swinney's Addition to the Village of Walworth, Walworth County, Wisconsin and described as follows; to wit: Commencing at the West corner of said Lot 19; thence Northerly along the West line of said Lot 20, 67 feet to the Northwest corner of said Lot 20; thence Easterly along the North line of said Lot 20, 89 feet to an iron pipe; thence Southeasterly at an angle of 113°40° 9.42 feet to an iron pipe and the place of beginning; thence continue on the same course 61.28 feet to an iron pipe; thence Southwesterly at an angle of 122°40° with the last course 82.35 feet to an iron pipe on the Southwesterly line of said Lot 19; thence Nor thwesterly along the Southwest side of said Lot 19, 70.67 feet to an iron pipe; thence Northeasterly at an angle of 91°56° with the last course 102.38 feet to the place of beginning.
