

MORTGAGE INSPECTION SURVEY



DESCRIPTION: A part of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 5, T 4 N, R 15 E, and bounded as follows: Commencing in the Northwest corner of lands conveyed to C. B. Kropf and wife to William J. Schulte by deed dated March 9, 1920, and recorded March 12, 1920 at 9 o'clock AM, in Volume 16 of Deeds at page 379 which corner is 4 1/4 rods West of the center of Prince Street and 1 1/2 rods and 76 1/2 links South of the East and West corner line of said Section 5, and running thence West on a continuation of the North line of the land owned by one George Denby, and in the South line of lands conveyed by G. M. Tritter to C. Denby and owned by Bill Harris, 4 rods East from South parallel to the West line of lands owned by one William Schulte as described in the deed recorded in Volume 15 of Deeds at page 379, 3 chains and 7 1/2 links to the street or boundary, intending to describe a strip of land 4 rods in width directly West of and adjoining the lands described in Volume 15 of Deeds at page 379, which strip is of equal width throughout its entire course.
