


PLAT OF SURVEY

IN THE COURSE OF THIS SURVEY, I DISCOVERED NORTH OF THE ALLEY IN BLOCK 1 A NORTH-SOUTH OVERAGE OF 10.9 FEET ON WHITON ST. AND 8.95 FEET ON SUMMIT ST.. AN EAST-WEST OVERAGE OF 4.8 FEET ON THE NORTHSIDE OF THE ALLEY AND 7.55 FEET ON THE NORTH END OF BLOCK 1. RESEARCH OF THE DEEDS FOR PARCELS NORTH OF THE ALLEY DID NOT HELP EXPLAIN THE OVERAGES. THEREFORE, I RETRACED A SURVEY BY JAMES F. BIAGI DATED FEBRUARY 28, 1972 AND DESCRIBED ON THE DEED. USING DEEDS, FOUND IRON MONUMENTS, OCCUPATION AND THE NORTH-SOUTH OVERAGE MADE THE EAST LINE OF THE SUBJECT PARCEL LONG 9.74 FEET.
