ORDINANCE NO. 1077 AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF WHITEWATER, WISCONSIN

The Common Council of the City of Whitewater, Walworth and Jefferson Counties, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Territory Annexed. In accordance with s. 66.021 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and the petition for direct annexation filed with the city clerk on the 11th day of February, 1986, signed by all of the owners of the land in the territory, with no electors residing in the territory, the following described territory in the Town of Whitewater, Walworth County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the City of Whitewater, Wisconsin:

A parcel of land beginning at a point in the West line of the Southeast quarter of Section 3, T4N, rise where said quarter line intersects the center of State Street; and running thence easterly along the center of said street extended to a point where the said centerline of State Street extended intersects a line 15 rods East and parallel with the West line of said quarter section; thence North and parallel with the said West line of said quarter section, 49.6 rods; thence West to the West line of said quarter section; thence South along said quarter section line to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2: Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this ordinance the territory described in Section 1 shall be a part of the city of Whitewater for any and all purposes provided by law, and all persons coming or residing with said territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the city of Whitewater.

SECTION 3: Zoning Classification. (a) Upon recommendation of the Plan Commission, the territory annexed to the City of Whitewater by this ordinance is designated to be part of the following district of the city for zoning purposes and subject to all provisions of Chapter No. 19 of the City of Whitewater entitled "Zoning" relating to such district classifications and to zoning in the city: All of the annexed territory shall be M-1 (General Manufacturing District).

(b) The boundaries of this designated district is established as shown on the attached map.

SECTION 4: Ward Designation. The territory described in Section 1 of this ordinance is hereby made a part of the first ward of the first aldermanic district of the City of Whitewater, subject to the ordinances, rules and regulations of the city governing wards.

SECTION 5. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

SECTION 6: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
