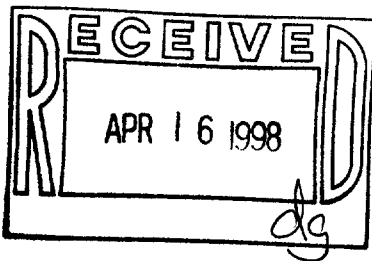


All that certain piece or parcel of land in Section 4, Township 4 North, Range 15 East, in the City of Whitewater and being a part of what is known as Fireman's Park, more particularly described as follows: Starting in the center of Whitewater Creek at the Southwest corner of land owned by Frank Krumwiede and Lillie Krumwiede as described in Warranty Deed recorded April 14, 1947 in Volume 365 of Deeds at Page 303 Document #397101, Walworth County Records; thence East on the South line of said Krumwiedes property to a point of intersection with the West line of George Street Lane; thence South along the West line of George Street Lane, 330 feet to the place of commencement; thence West parallel with Krumwiedes South line to the center of Whitewater Creek; thence Northerly and following along the center line of said creek to the Southwest corner of Spartaco M. Mucci's and Kathryn Vera Mucci's lot as described in Warranty Deed recorded November 12, 1948 in Volume 392 of Deeds at Page 13, Walworth County Records; thence East along Mucci's South line to the West line of George Street Lane; thence South 66 feet to place of commencement. Together with a right of way to travel over George Street Lane as presently located. The intention being to describe a parcel of land 66 feet of even width bounded on the East by George Street Lane and on the West by the center of Whitewater Creek.
