witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other good valuable consideration to them in hand paid by the said party of second part, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, have given, granted, bargained, sold, remised, released, aliened, conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do give, grant, bargain, sell, remise, release, alien, convey and confirm unto the said party of the and part, his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real situated in the County of Walworth and State of Wisconsin, to-wit:

AMCEL I: A parcel of land located in the Southwest Quarter of Section 1 and the Northwest Quarter of Section 12, Town 1 North Range 16 East of Walworth County, Wisconsin, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a stake in the South line of Elock 6 of Grand Terrace Subdivision, according to the plat thereof which is recorded in the Register of Deeds Office in and for said County in Vol. 5 of Plats on page 15, 212 feet West of the Southeast corner of said Elock 6; thence South parallel with the North and South Quarter section lines of said Sections 1 and 12, 850 feet more or last to the shore of Geneva Lake at low water line; thence Westerly alon low water line of said lake to a point that is located 50 feet West read at right angles) of the first course; thence North parallel to rest course to a point that is located 514 feet South of the South line of said Block 6; thence West 2,4 feet thence North 514 ft. to the South line of said Block 6; thence East 52.4 feet to the place of beginning.
