DESCRIPTION:

Commencing at the northwest corner of Lot 18, Block 3, Wooddale Addition; a subdivision of a portion of the E. $\frac{1}{2}$ of the S.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, and a portion of the E. $\frac{1}{2}$, of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, Town 1, north, Range 17 east of the 4th Principal Meridian, thence southeasterly along the westerly line of the said Lot 18 and the southerly extension of the westerly line of Lot 18, across Lots 20 and 21 in said Block 3; 198.0 feet to an iron stake in the westerly line of Lot 21, thence southeasterly along the westerly line of Lot 21; 72.7 feet to the southwest corner of Lot 21; thence easterly along the south line of Lot 21; 66.7 feet to an iron stake, thence northwesterly along the southerly extension of the easterly line of said Lot 18, and the easterly line of said Lot 18; 279.0 feet to the northeast corner of Lot 18, thence southwesterly along the north line of Lot 18; 90.0 feet to the place of beginning.
