OF THE 4TH P.M., TOWNSHIP OF SPRING PRAIRIE, COUNTY OF WALWORTH, STATE OF WISCONSIN AND MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: COMMENCE AT A STONE MONUMENT AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SAID SECTION 13, THENCE N. 0°08'30" E., ALONG THE WEST LINE OF SAID QUARTER SECTION, 963.92 FEET; THENCE N. 88°17' E., ALONG POTTER ROAD, 421.37 FEET; THENCE N. 86°08'18" E., ALONG POTTER ROAD, 333.02 FEET; THENCE N. 84°25'23" E., ALONG POTTER ROAD, 525.80 FEET TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING OF PARCEL OF LAND HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED: THENCE N. 84°25'23" E., ALONG POTTER ROAD, 36.33 FEET; THENCE N. 84°48'20" E., 264.67 FEET ALONG POTTER ROAD; THENCE N. 5°27' W., 857.13 FEET TO AN IRON PIPE STAKE; THENCE N. 88°28'20" W., 303.24 FEET TO AN IRON PIPE STAKE; THENCE S. 5°27' E., 892.86 FEET TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING. 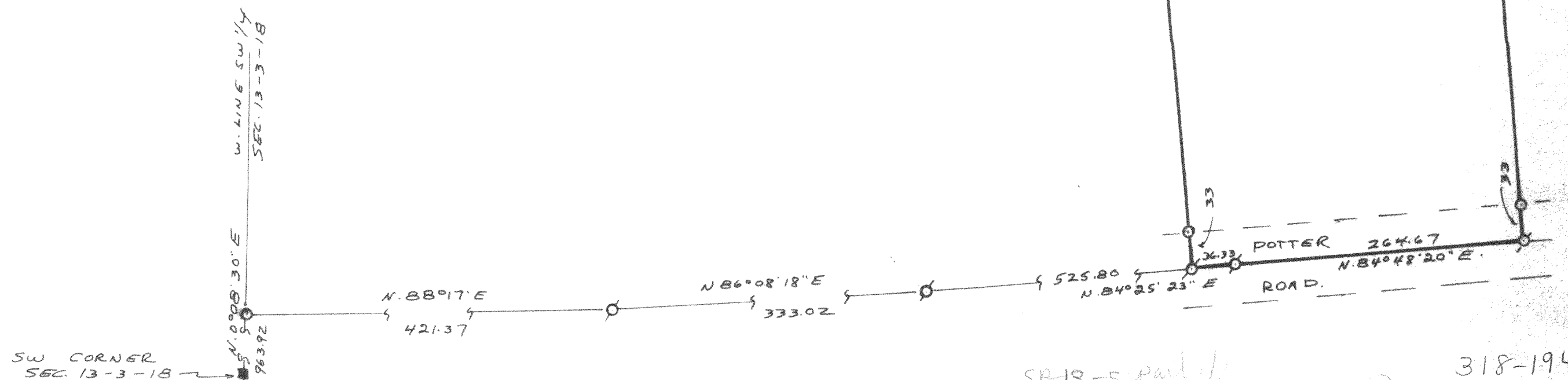
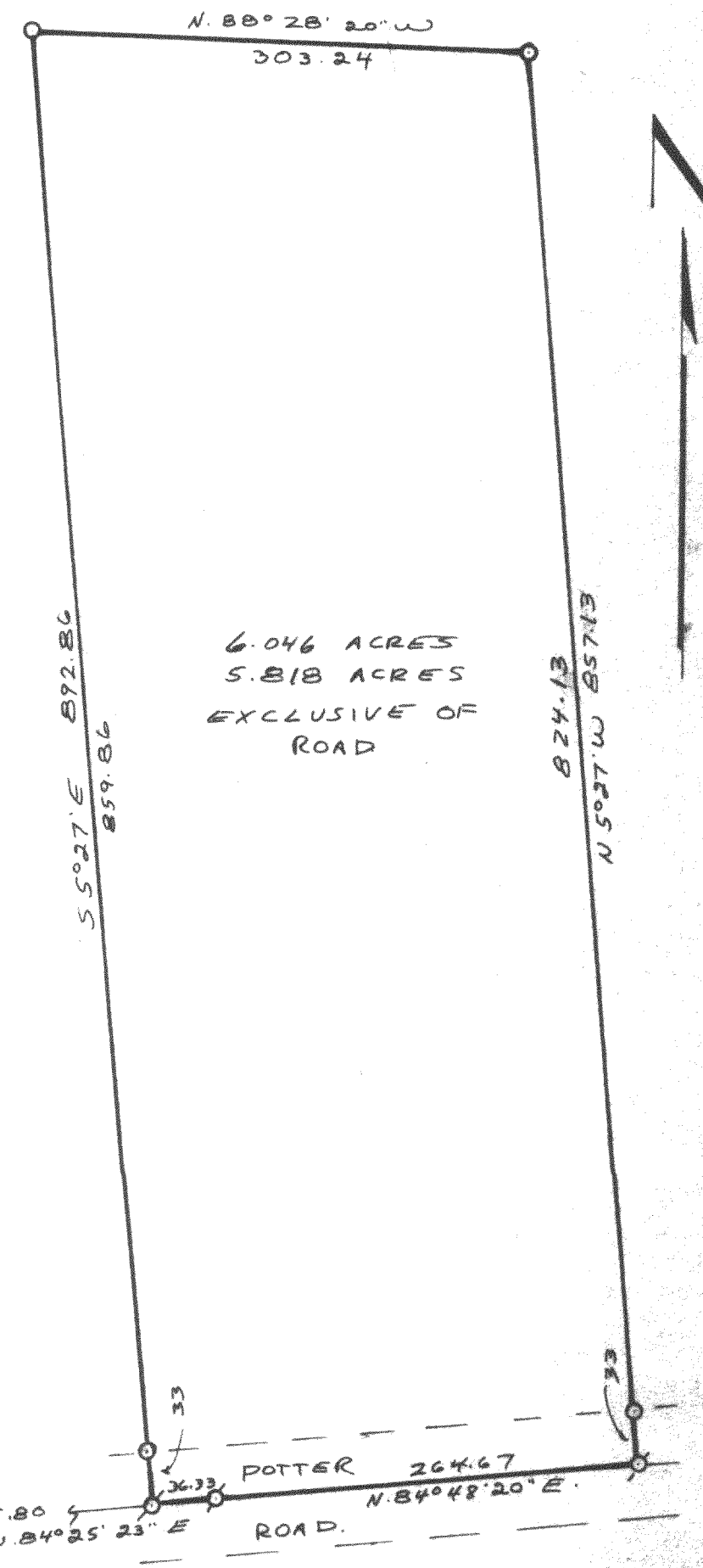
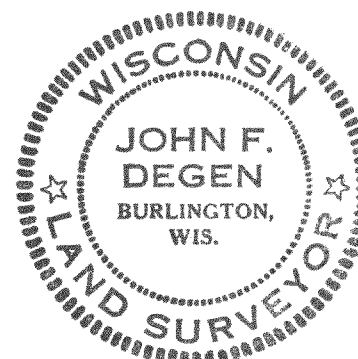
o = IRON PIPE STAKE SET OR FOUND AS NOTED ON PLAT.
