


Also right of way for pedestrian travel to the lake between the Northeast corner of Lot 1, Block 2, Carswell's Park, and the North stone post of the bridge, which access may be more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the Southeast corner of said Lot 1; thence North 23 degrees 23 minutes East 110.1 feet; thence North 56 degrees 10 minutes East 19.1 feet to the Northernly line of said bridge and the shore of Middle Lake; thence Northwest along the shore 117 feet more or less to the Northeast corner of said Lot 1; thence South 15 degrees 56 minutes East along the Easterly line of said Lot 1, 164 feet more or less to the place of beginning.
