



The following-described real estate in the County of Walworth, being a part of Block 1 of Carswells Park; from an iron stake that is witnessed by a spike in the root of a white oak tree, northerly 7 feet, and spike in a second white oak tree, westerly 20 feet, and said iron stake being 182 feet North and 297.5 feet East of the Northwest corner of Lot 1, in Block 1 of the plat of Carswells Park which plat is on record in the Register of Deeds office in and for the said County in Volume 5 of Plats on page 118; go N 31° 30' West 131.5 feet to an iron stake on the drive, the place of beginning of this description; thence N 81° East 30 feet to an iron stake; thence N 2° 45' West 124 feet to an iron stake on the shore of Middle Lake; thence westerly being along the said shore 50 feet, more or less, to an irion stake that is 50 feet distant in a line from the last-mentioned iron stake; thence S 13° East 115 feet to the place of beginning. Also a parcel of land located in Block 1, Carswells Park, described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at an iron stake located 182 feet North and 297.5 feet East of the Northwest corner of Lot 1, Block l of the plat of Carswells Park; thence N 31° 30' West 131.5 feet; thence N 81° East 30.00 feet; thence N 2° 45' West 124.00 feet to an iron stake and the place of beginning; thence S 2° 45' East 124.0 feet; thence N 81° East 2.00 feet; thence N 1° 22' East 126.03 feet, more or less, to the shore of Lauderdale Lake; thence westerly along the shore of Lauderdale Lake 10.00 feet to a point located N 2° 45' West 6.00 feet, more or less from the place of beginning; thence S 2° 45' East 6.00 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning.
