
Plat of Survey

A strip 50 feet in width, situated in the Southeast ¼ of the Northwest ¼ of Section 4, Township 4 North, Range 18 East, in the Town of East Troy, Walworth County, Wisconsin, and bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point 541.5 feet South of the 1/8th post and 631.5 feet West from the ¼ Section line of said Section 4, which said point of beginning is also described as being North 36°20′ West 250 feet from the Northeast corner of a Lot hereto conveyed to one G.W. Pitts, said point of beginning is marked by a galvanized iron gas pipe and is witnesses by a burr oak 20 inches diameter, bearing North 78°45′ West 50.4 feet; thence from said point of beginning North 36°20′ West 50 feet to a stake; thence South 47°55′ West 332 feet to the lake, said last described line constituting the North Westerly boundary line of the land hereby conveyed; thence South along the lake following the low water line thereof, 50 feet more or less to a point where a line projected from the point of beginning of this tract at an angle South 47°58′ West will intersect said low water line; thence North 47°58′ East along said projected line 325 feet more or less to the said point of beginning.



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
