Part of the Northeast 1/4, Northwest 1/4 and Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 36, Township 4 North, Range 18 East of the 4th Principal Meridian in the Township of East Troy, Walworth County, Wisconsin and being more particularly described as follows: Commence at the West 1/4 corner of said Section 36; thence South 89 ^o 54'55" East 1419.00 feet to a found iron pipe; thence South 200.00 feet to a found iron pipe and the place of beginning of a parcel of land hereinafter described: thence continue South 1120.00 feet to a found iron pipe; thence North 89 ^o 54'55" West 143.88 feet to a found iron pipe; thence South 38 ^o 28'35" West 1311.49 feet to a point in the centerline of Honey Creek Road; thence North 33 ^o 44'05" West along said centerline 400.00 feet; thence North 33 ^o 08'25" East 2184.92 feet to the place of beginning. Reserving a strip of land 25.08 feet wide and 318.12 feet long, so laid out as to cover a spring and the outlet thereof, situated near the Southeast part of the above described premises. Subject to the rights of the public over the Southwest 33.00 feet for road purposes. (Honey Creek Road). Containing 20.00 acres of land more or less, including right of way.
