

DESCRIPTION:

Commencing at an iron stake in the shore of Beulah Lake, that is 189.15 feet north of and 135.46 feet west of the west  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Section 9, Town 4 north, Range 18 east of the 4th Principal Meridian, thence S.  $54^{\circ} 57'$  E., 97.23 feet to a point, thence S.  $28^{\circ} 11'$  E., 118.27 feet to a point, in the west line of said section 9; thence south in the said section line 29.56 feet to a point, ( the west  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said section 9 ) thence S.  $61^{\circ}$  E., 1360.26 feet to a point, thence N.  $0^{\circ} 30'$  W., 716.8 feet to a point, thence N.  $87^{\circ}$  W., 161.7 feet to a point, thence N.  $16^{\circ}$  W., 396.0 feet to a point, thence N.  $12^{\circ}$  E., 338.0 feet to a point, thence North 186.64 feet to a point, thence N.  $43^{\circ}$  E., 25.5 feet to a point, thence N.  $10^{\circ}$  W., 48.18 feet to a point, thence N.  $44^{\circ}$  W., 286.44 feet to the shore of Beulah Lake, thence meandering westerly and southwesterly along the shore of said Beulah Lake, 1462.0 feet more or less to the place of beginning.
