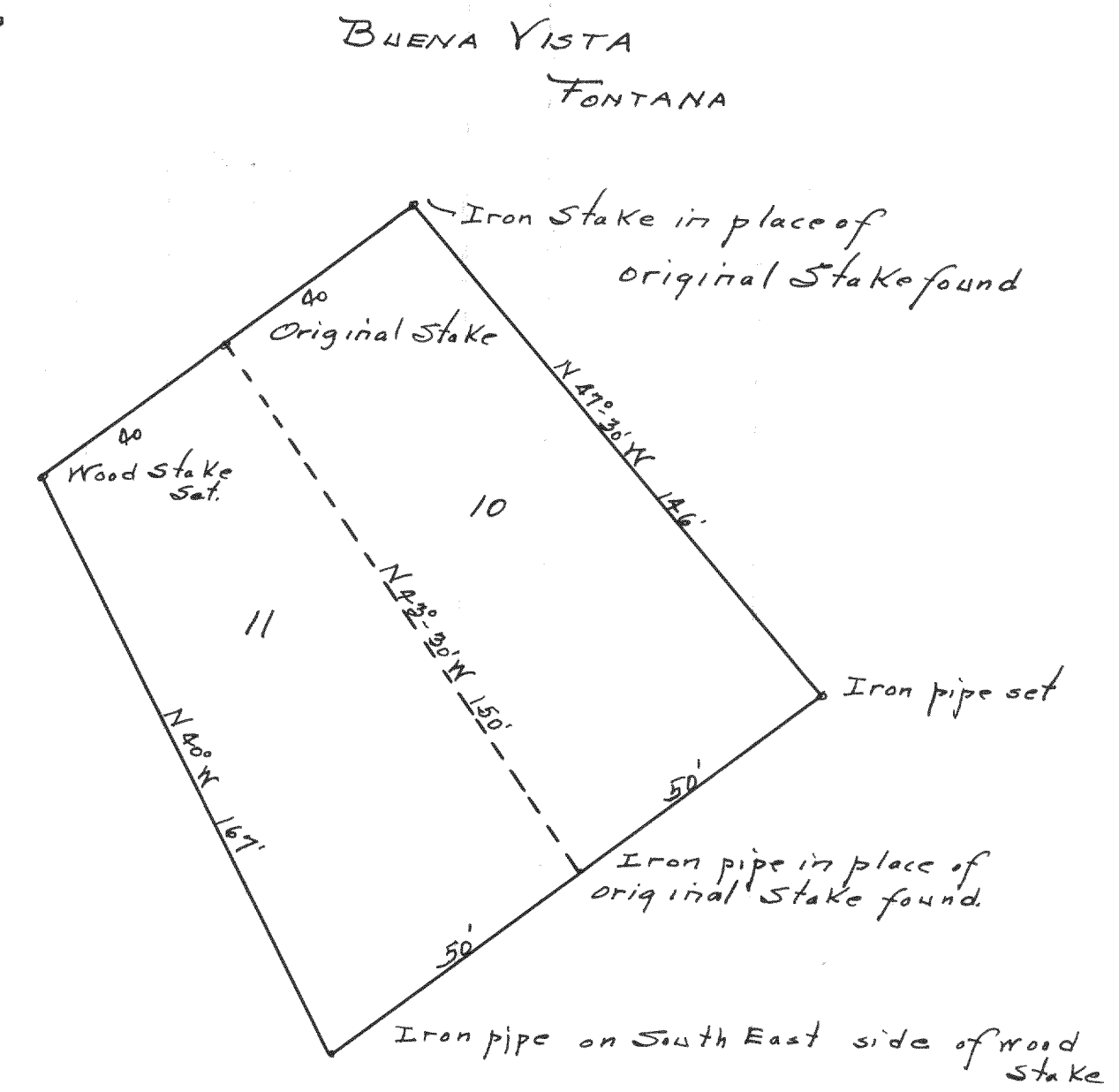

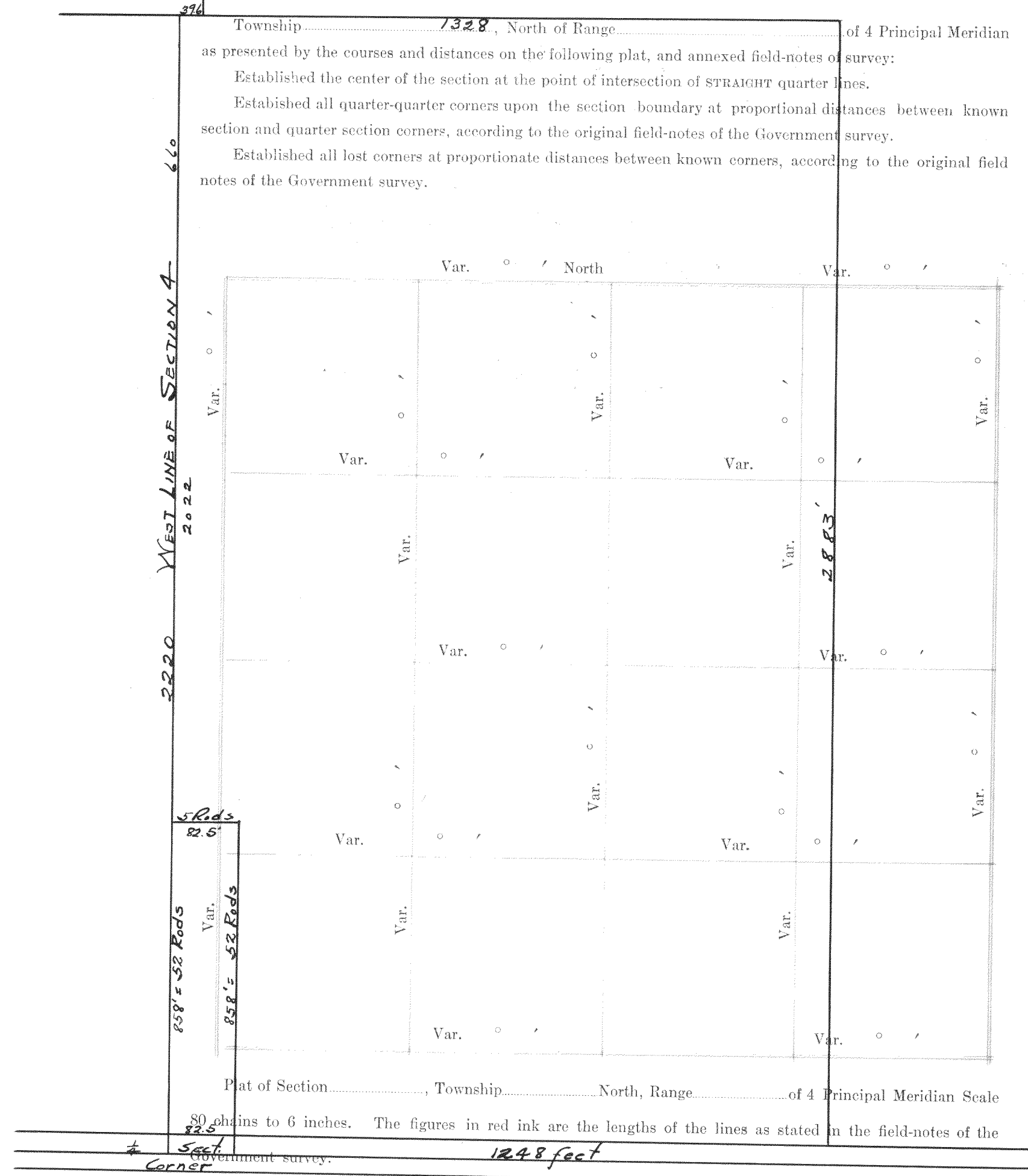

I, William Child, County Surveyor of Walworth County, Wis., do hereby certify that I did on the 28th of Dec., 1911, make a survey for the purpose of locating and establishing that portion of the section line between Sections 10 & 11 in T1N, R16E, between the northwest corner and the west quarter section corner of said section 11, and that I did at that time find an iron stake driven for the NW corner of said section 11 and which stake was proven to be the said NW corner by the government witness tree which is still standing; that at the West $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner of said section 11 I found an old stake which I had proven correct in a former survey. I further certify that the line of stakes shown me by A. S. Rosiny chief engineer, of the Lake Geneva and Lake Kalamoon Electric Railway Company, as being the $\frac{1}{2}$ of said railway right of way are one & one half ($1\frac{1}{2}$) rods east of the west line of said section 11.

I further certify that I find the paper relating to a highway known as the Elkhorn Bigfoot Highway, on file in the office of the County Clerk for Walworth County and a record thereof in the records of roads in said office on page 29 of said record; that the report of the viewers of said road was accepted, and ordered recorded Jan. 8, 1840, and the said road extends in a southerly and southwesterly direction until it reaches the northwest corner of said section 11 and thence South 40 chains to the $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner, thence south etc.
