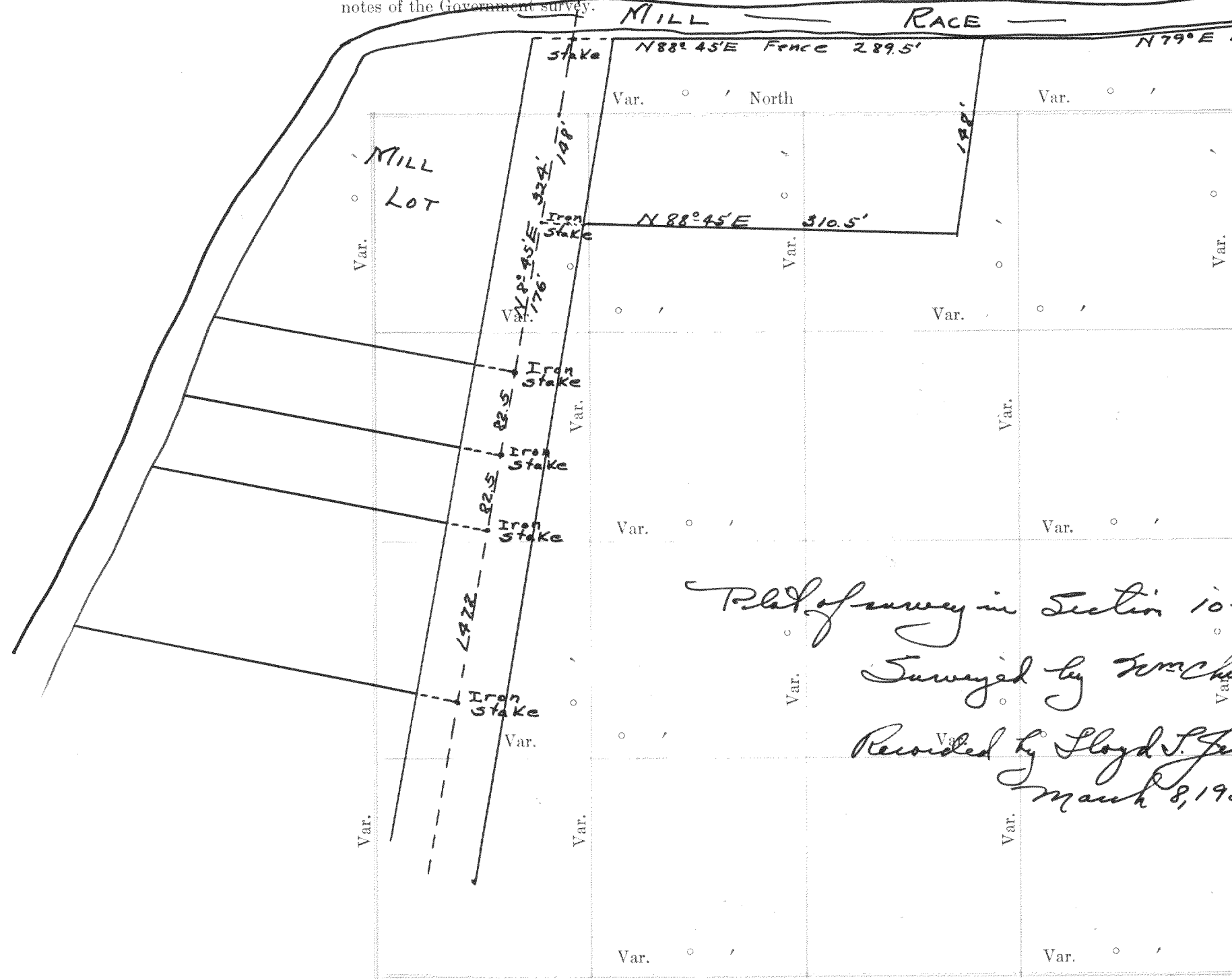

 as presented by the courses and distances on the following plat and annexed field-notes of survey:
 Established the center of the section at the point of intersection of STRAIGHT corner lines.
 Established all quarter-quarter corners upon the section boundary at proportional distances between known section and quarter section corners, according to the original field-notes of the Government survey.
 Established all lost corners at proportionate distances between known corners, according to the original field notes of the Government survey.

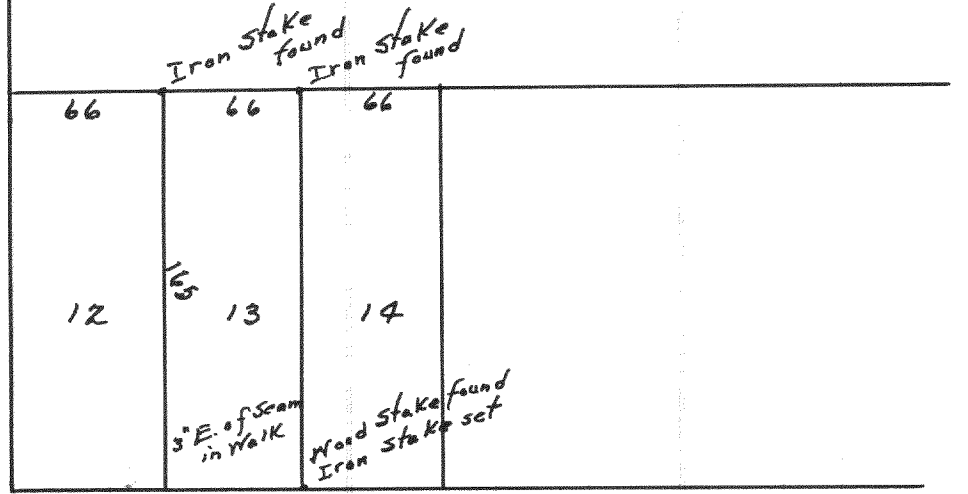

Found old stake at SW. corner of block 5 of Wm Bay, also stakes and stake holes of lots on West line of block, and as angle stake in road is gone, I set stake at 65 + 38.35 north from iron stake found at corner of lot. Produced the west line of block South 70 feet and find stake hole and set iron stake from this stake, west on line to point on $\frac{1}{8}$ line 247.5 feet = 3.75 chains north of $\frac{1}{8}$ post 66 feet and set monument for corner of plot. Then west 237.6 feet to $\frac{1}{8}$ line and set monument north on $\frac{1}{8}$ line 70 and set iron stake for northwest corner of lot 4 and southwest of lot 3. Then 263.5 feet more to center of road 11.6 feet northeast at Red cedar stake at angle at road. Set monument northeast 118.5 feet being point 102.1 from monument at Right angle to $\frac{1}{8}$ post.
